Why Advocate?




- H.B. 11 (Rep. Manning (R-55) Rep. Howse (D-11)
 Regards tobacco cessation and prenatal initiatives (passed by the House)
- H.B. 40 (Rep. West (D-49) Rep. Galonski (D-35) Regards testing pregnant women for sex transmitted diseases (Introduced)
- H.B. 165 (Rep. Liston (D-21) and Rep. Galonski (D-35) Regards adoption of health education standards (Introduced)

State Advocacy (continued)

- H.B. 297 (Rep Ginter (R-5) Rep. Powell (R-80) Grant tax credit-contribute cash to pregnancy resource center (Introduced)
- S.B. 121 (Sen. Sykes (D-28) Sen. Kunze (R-16)
 Adopt health education standards/GA need only approve Venereal Disease education
