




Quarterly Rolling 12-Month Average Infant Mortality Rates per 1,000 Births






Quarterly Rolling 12-Month Average Sudden Unexpected Infant Death (SUID) Rates per 1,000 Births























Neonatal Mortality, by Region and Race





























Postneonatal Mortality, by Region and Race

















































Prematurity, by Region and Race


Central Region Percentage Preterm (<37 Weeks) Births

























Extreme Prematurity, by Region and Race

Central Region Percentage Extreme Preterm (<28 Weeks) Births












