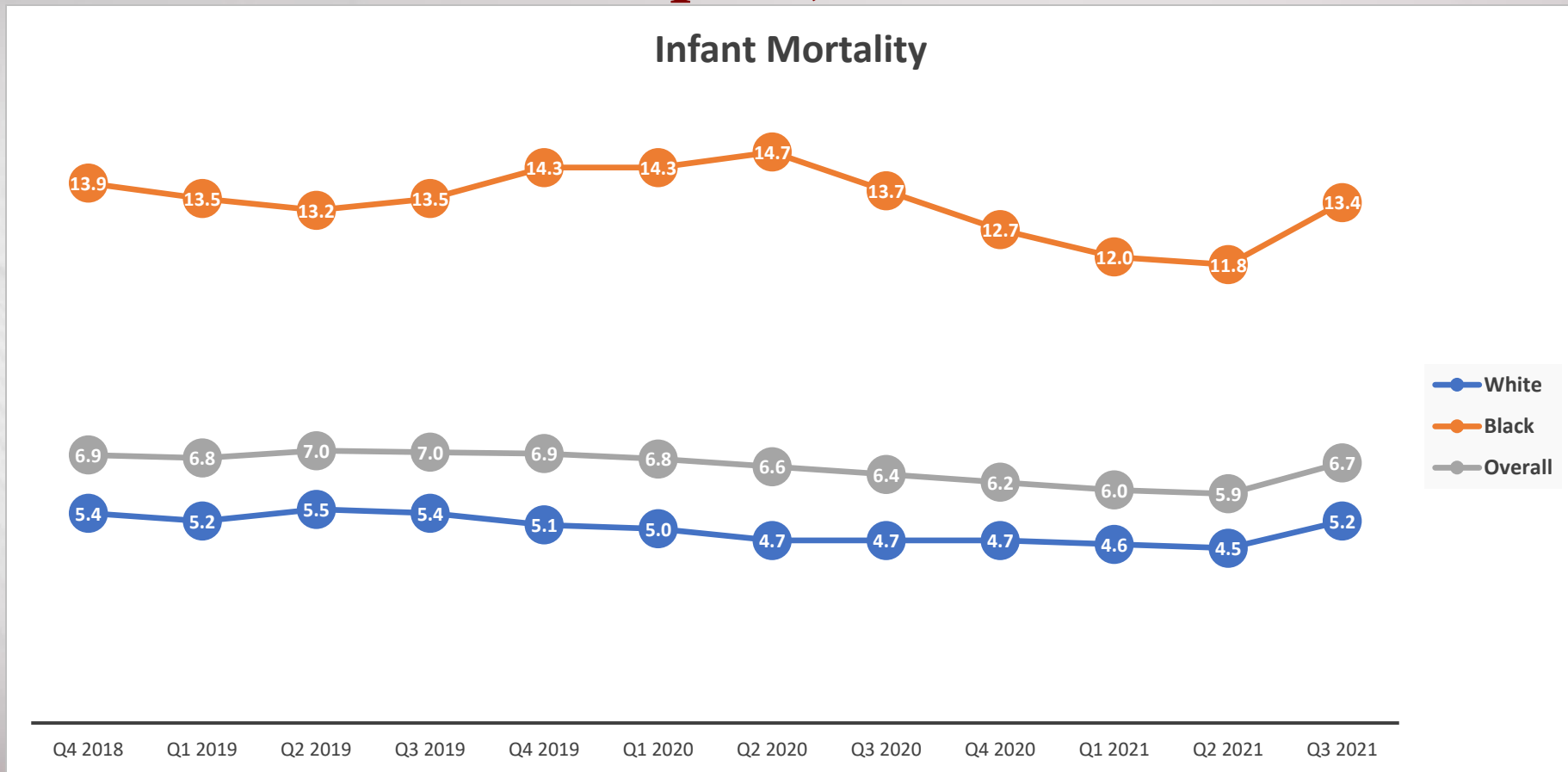

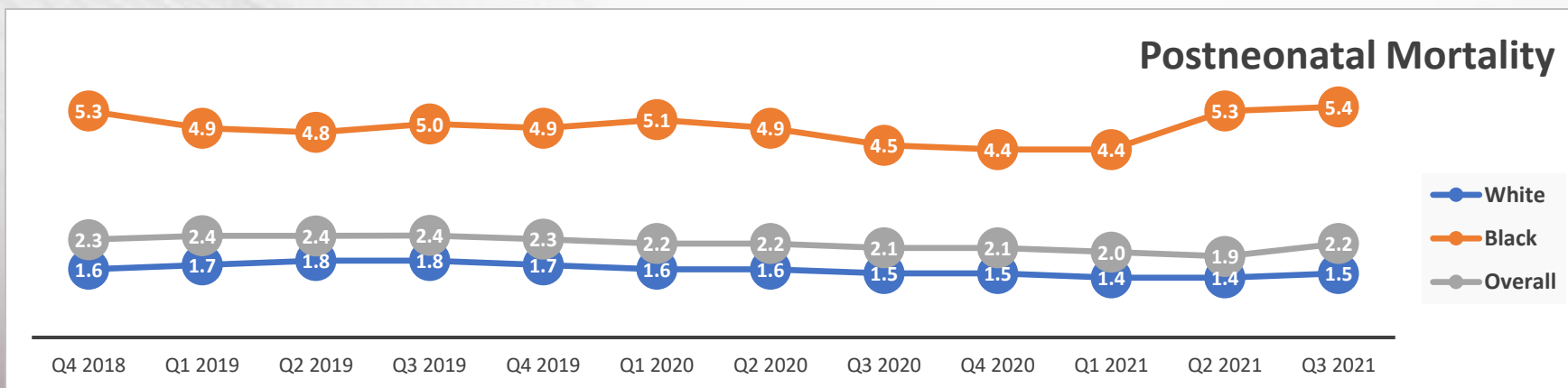
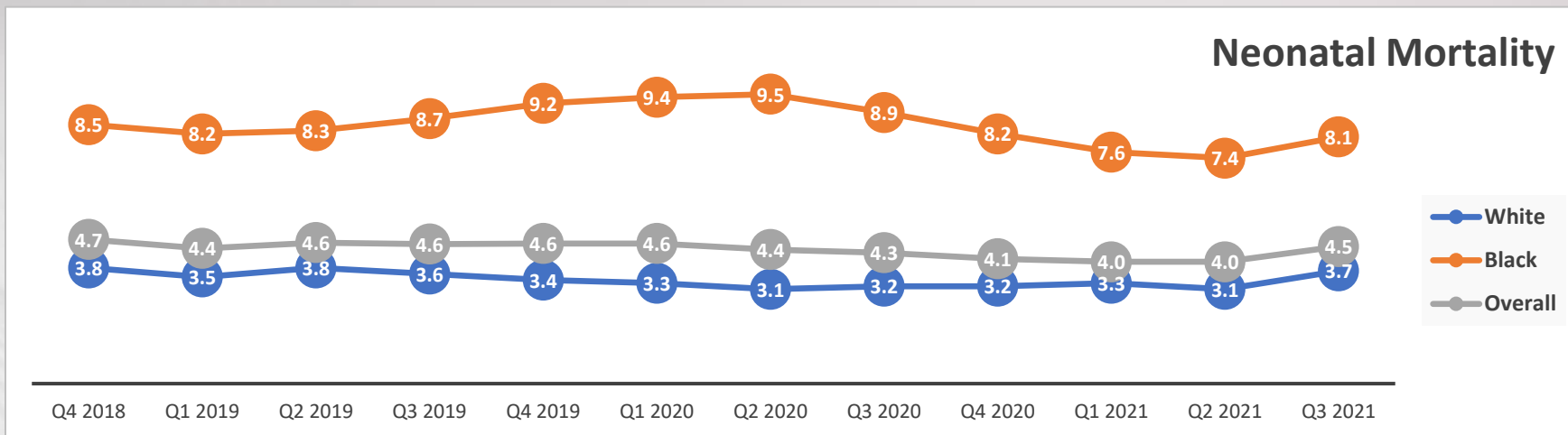


Quarterly Rolling 12-Month Average Infant Mortality Rates per 1,000 Births

Quarterly Rolling 12-Month Average Neonatal and Postneonatal Mortality Rates per 1,000 Births

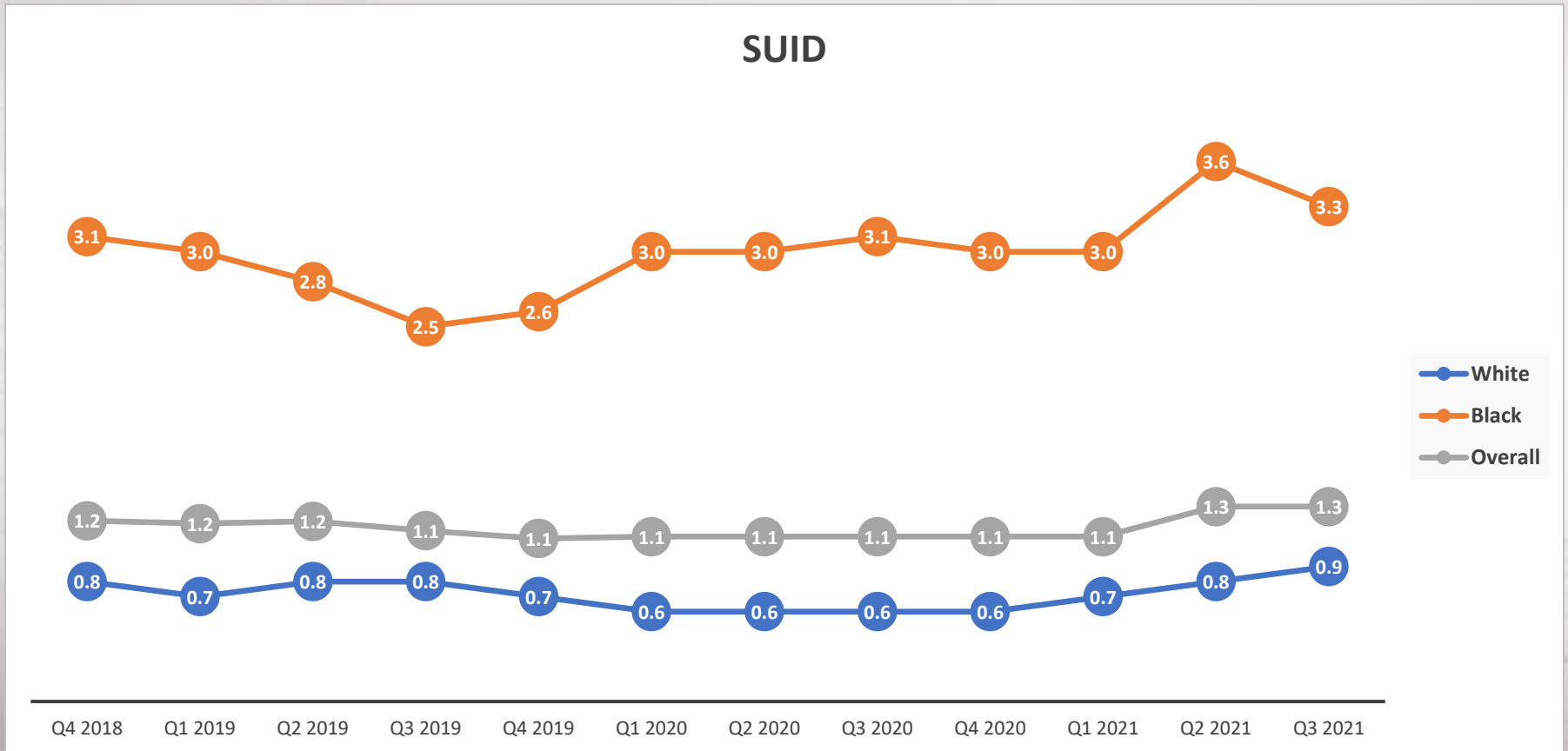

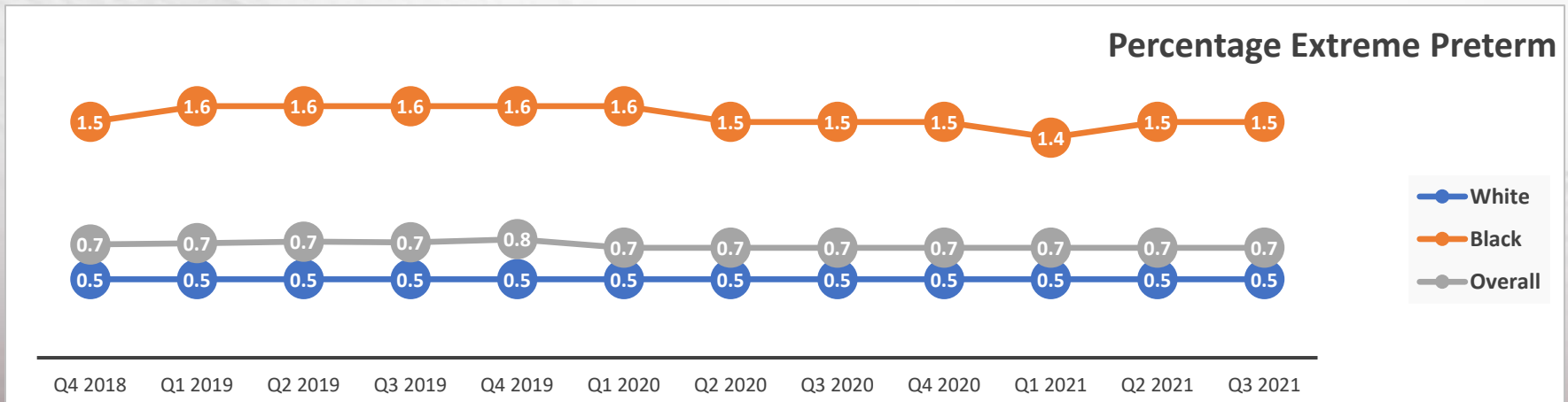
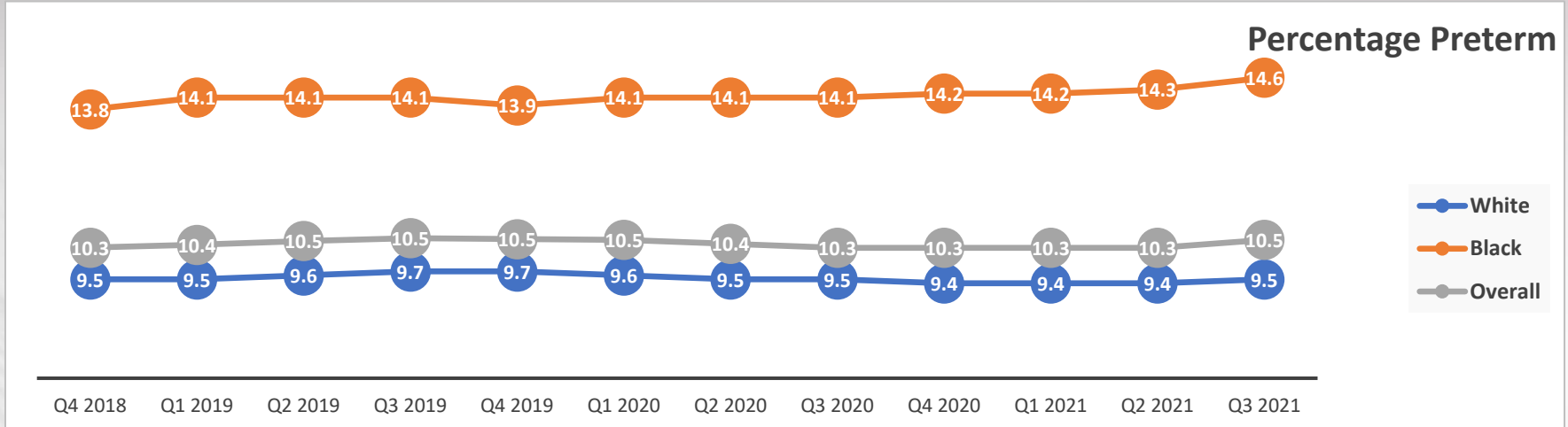

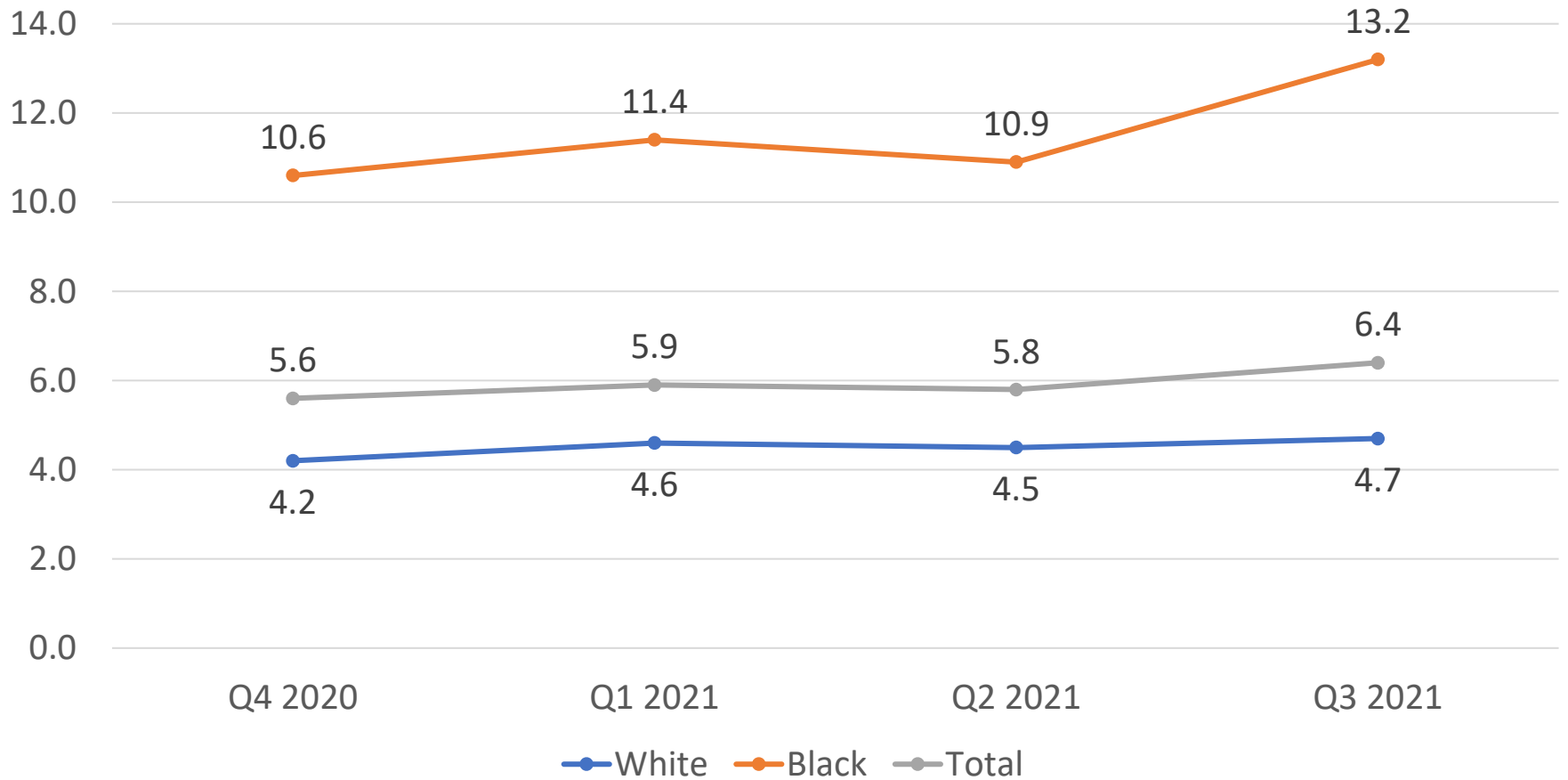

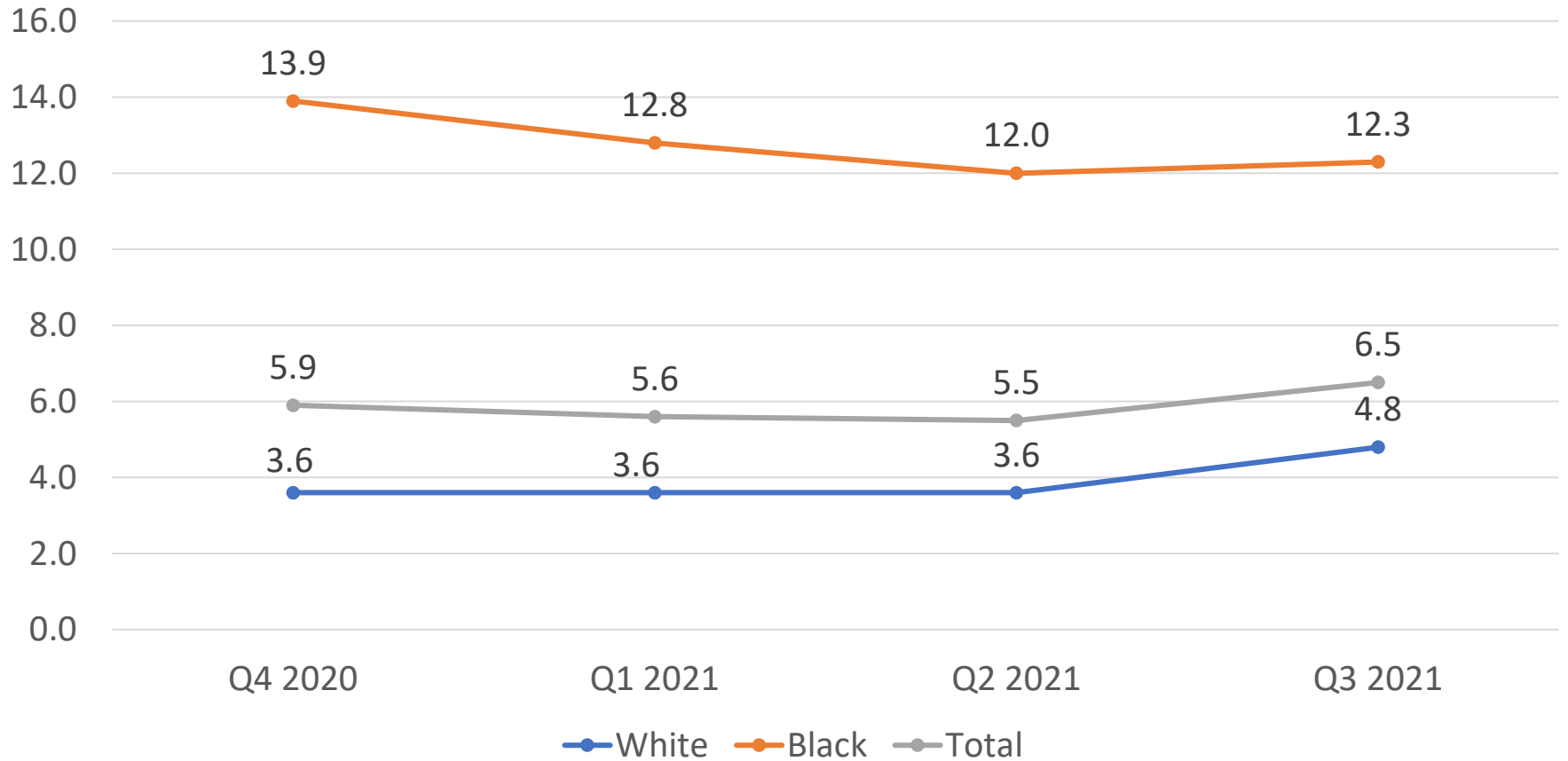

Central Region Infant Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



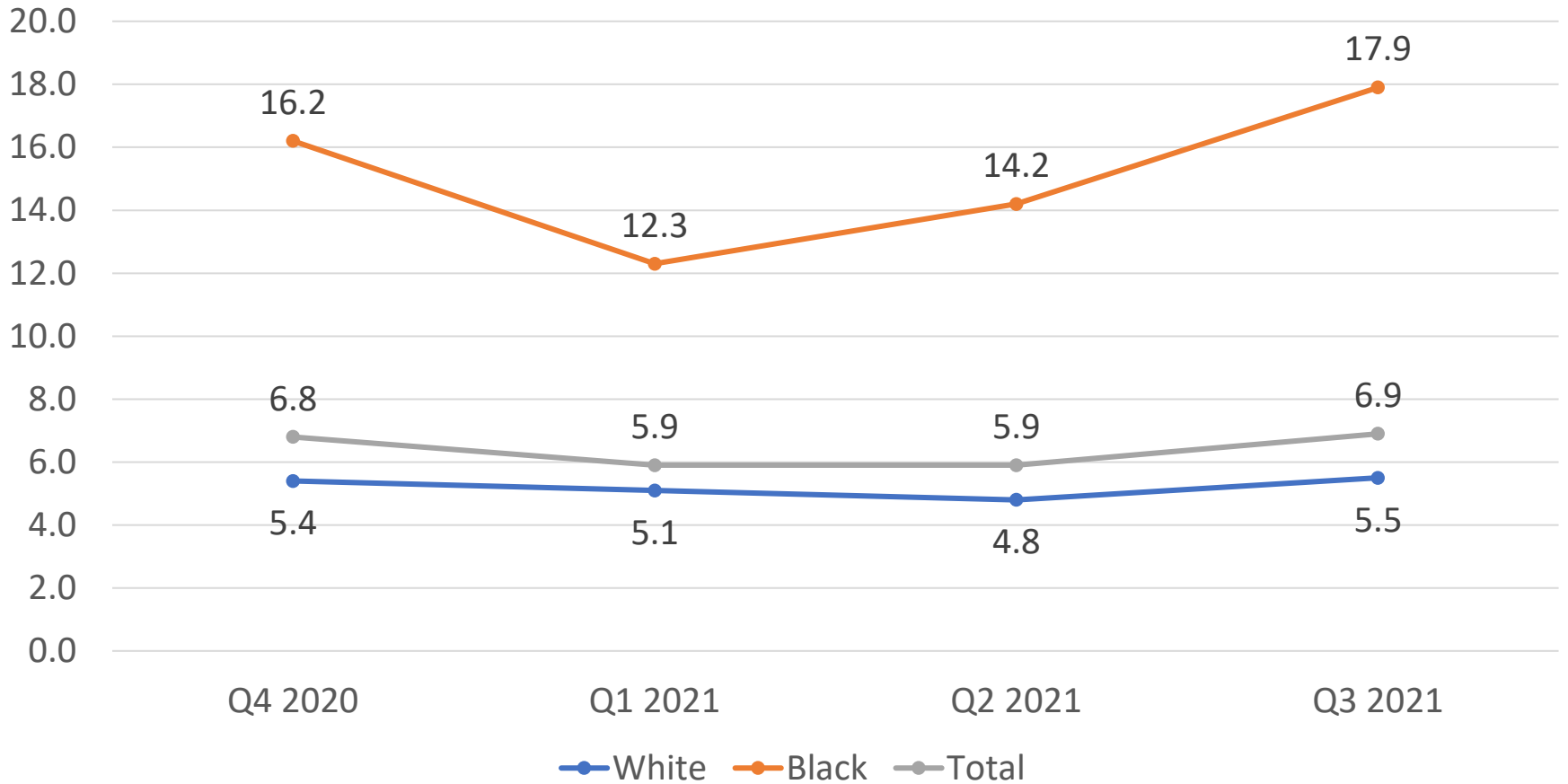

Northeast Region Infant Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



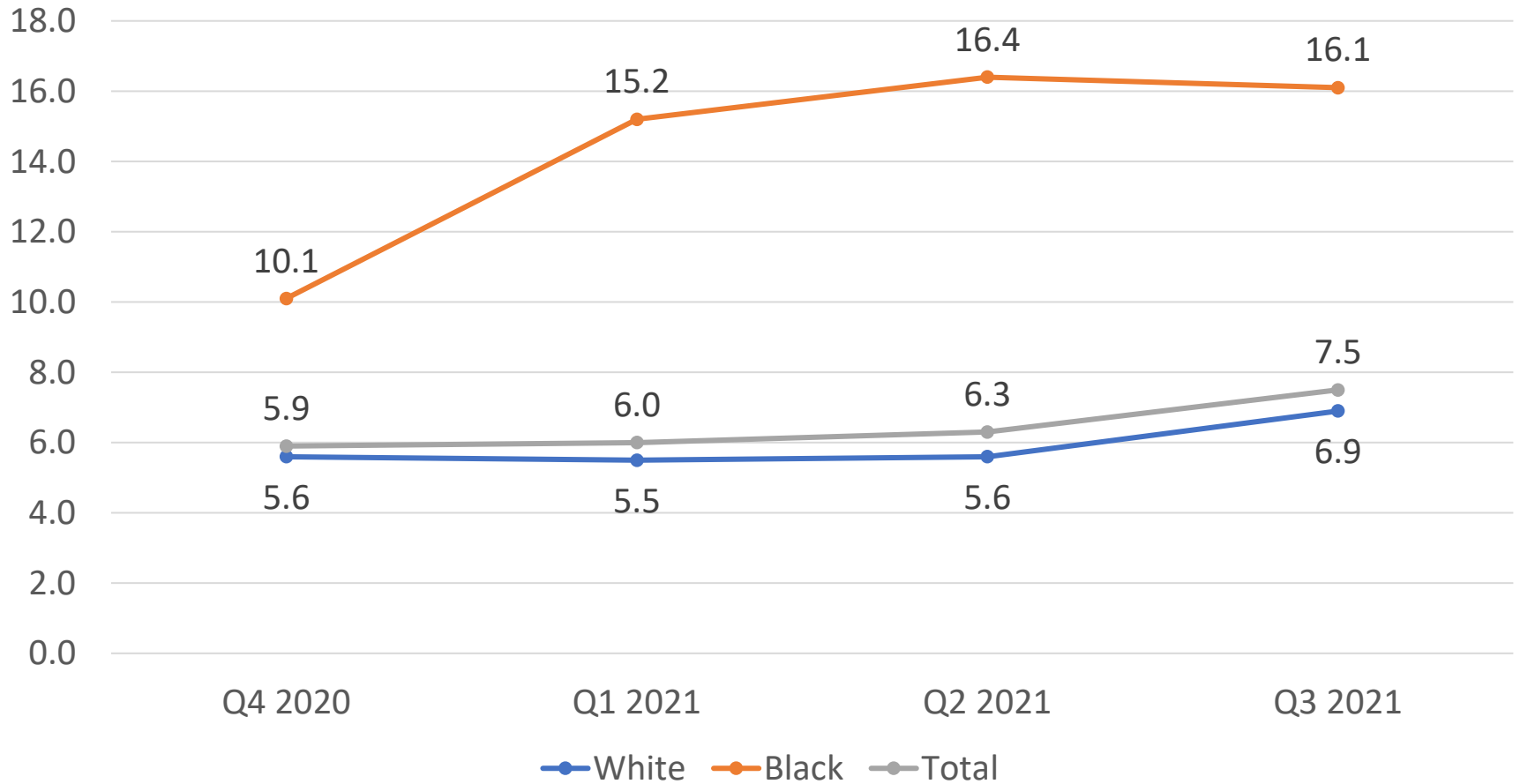

Northwest Region Infant Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



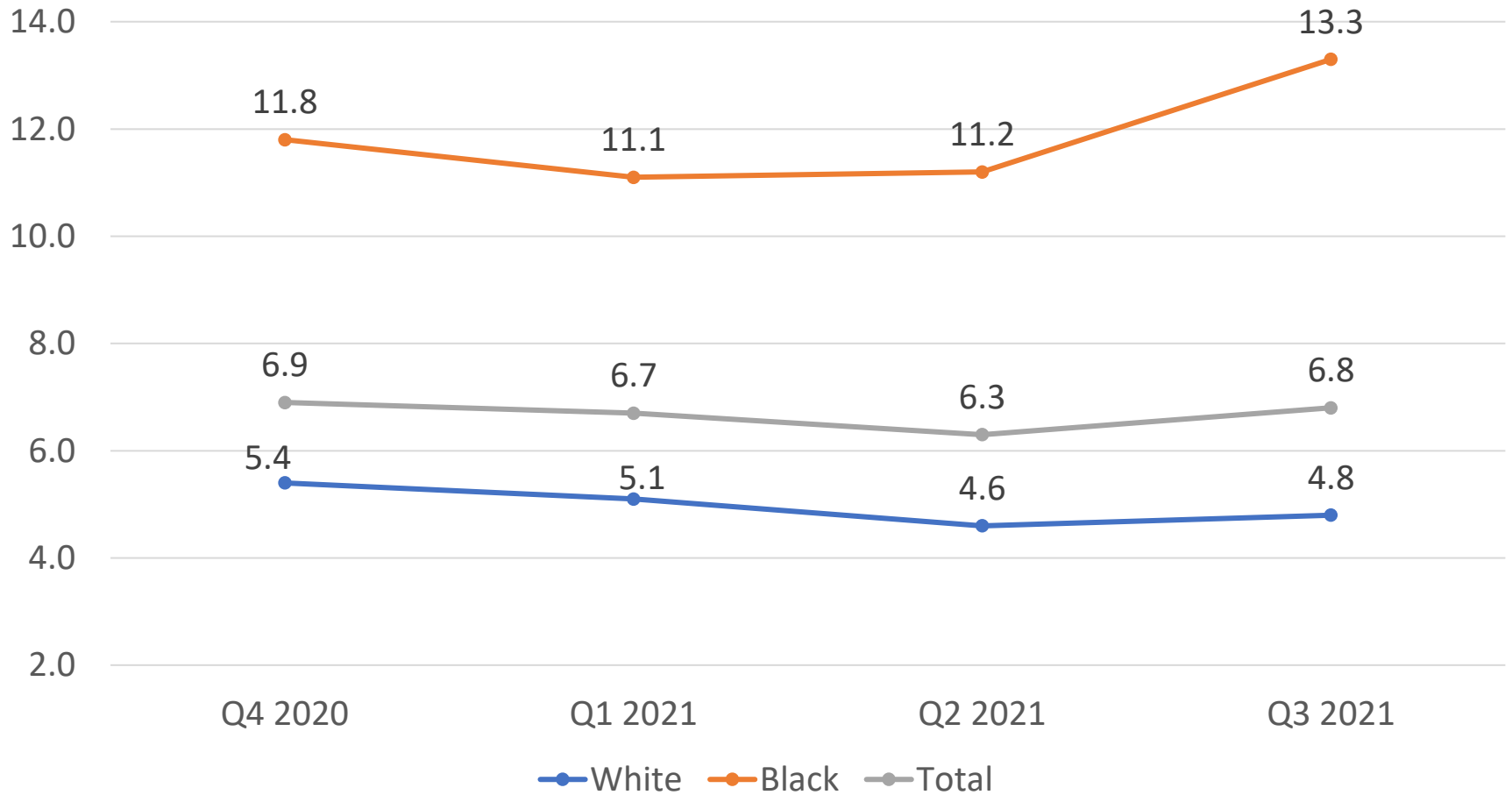

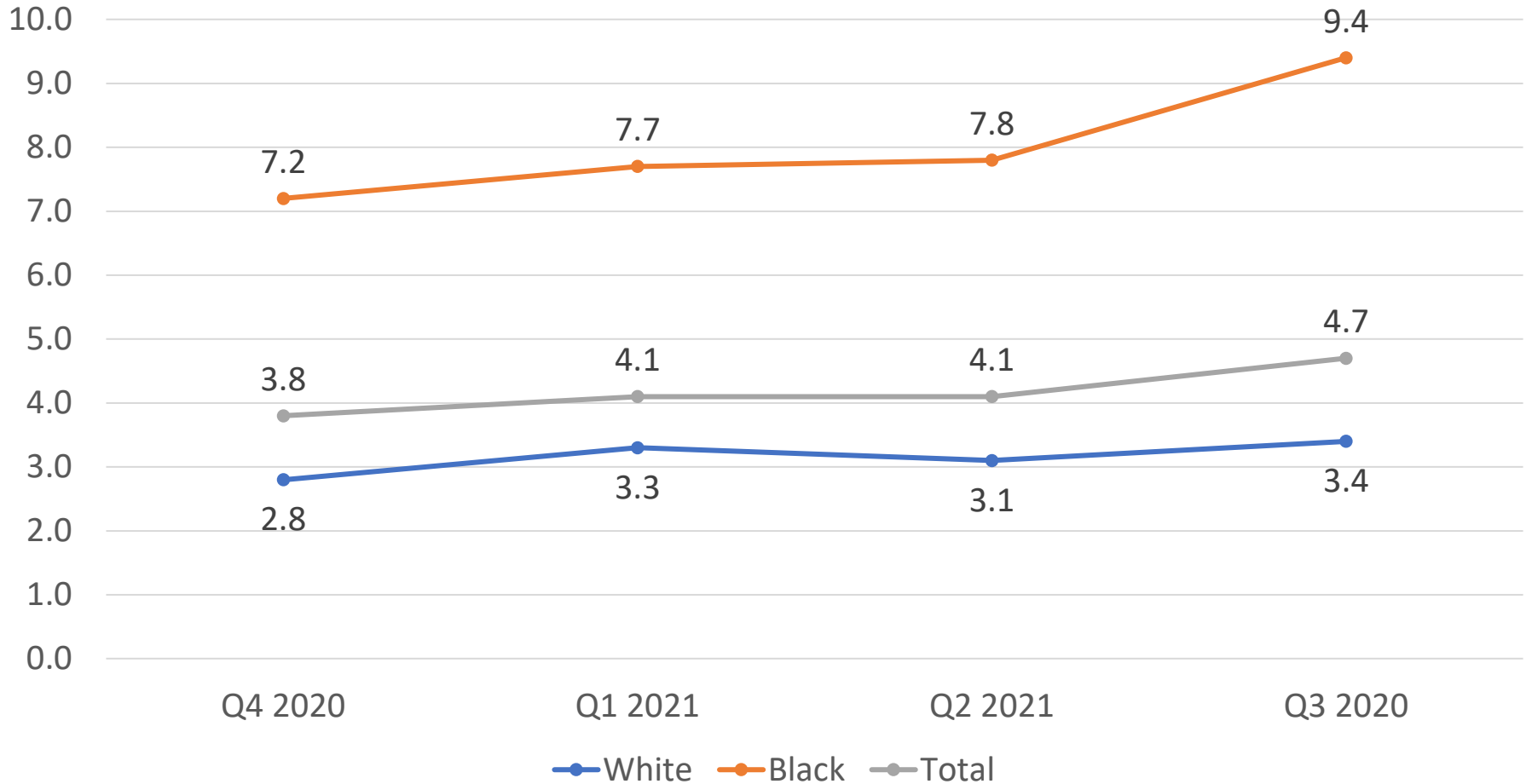
Southwest Region Infant Mortality Rates (per 1,000)

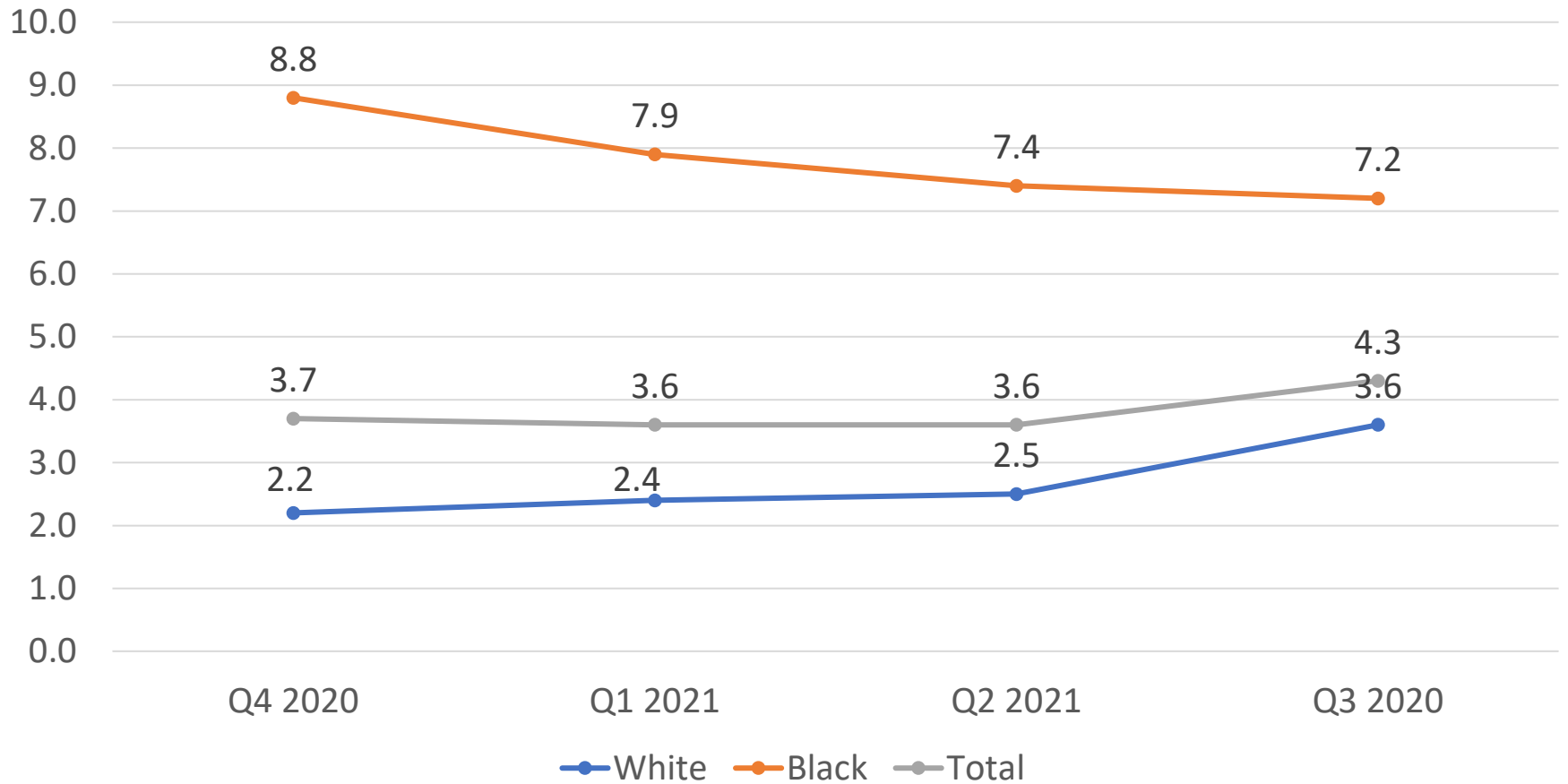

Central Region Neonatal Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



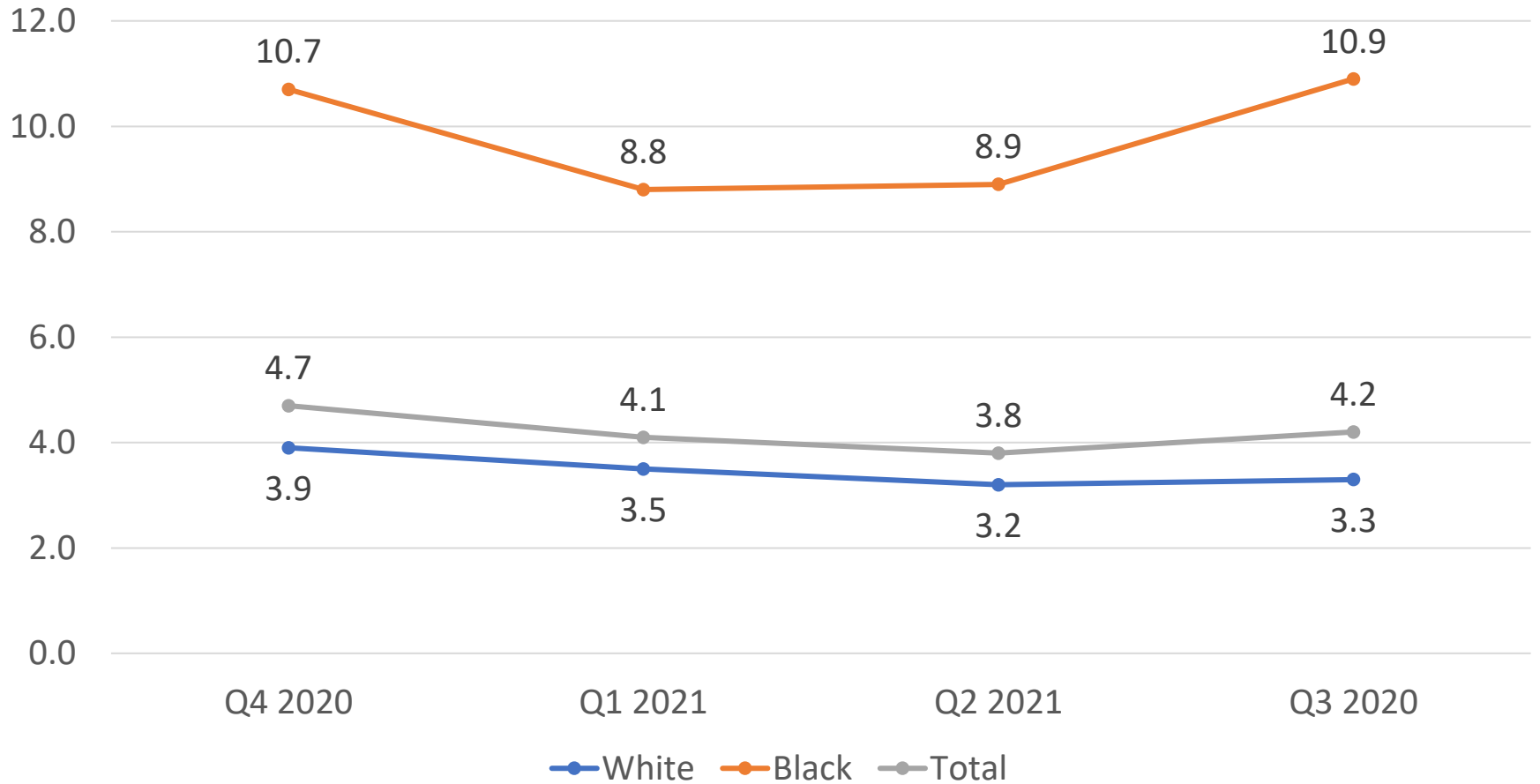

Northeast Region Neonatal Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



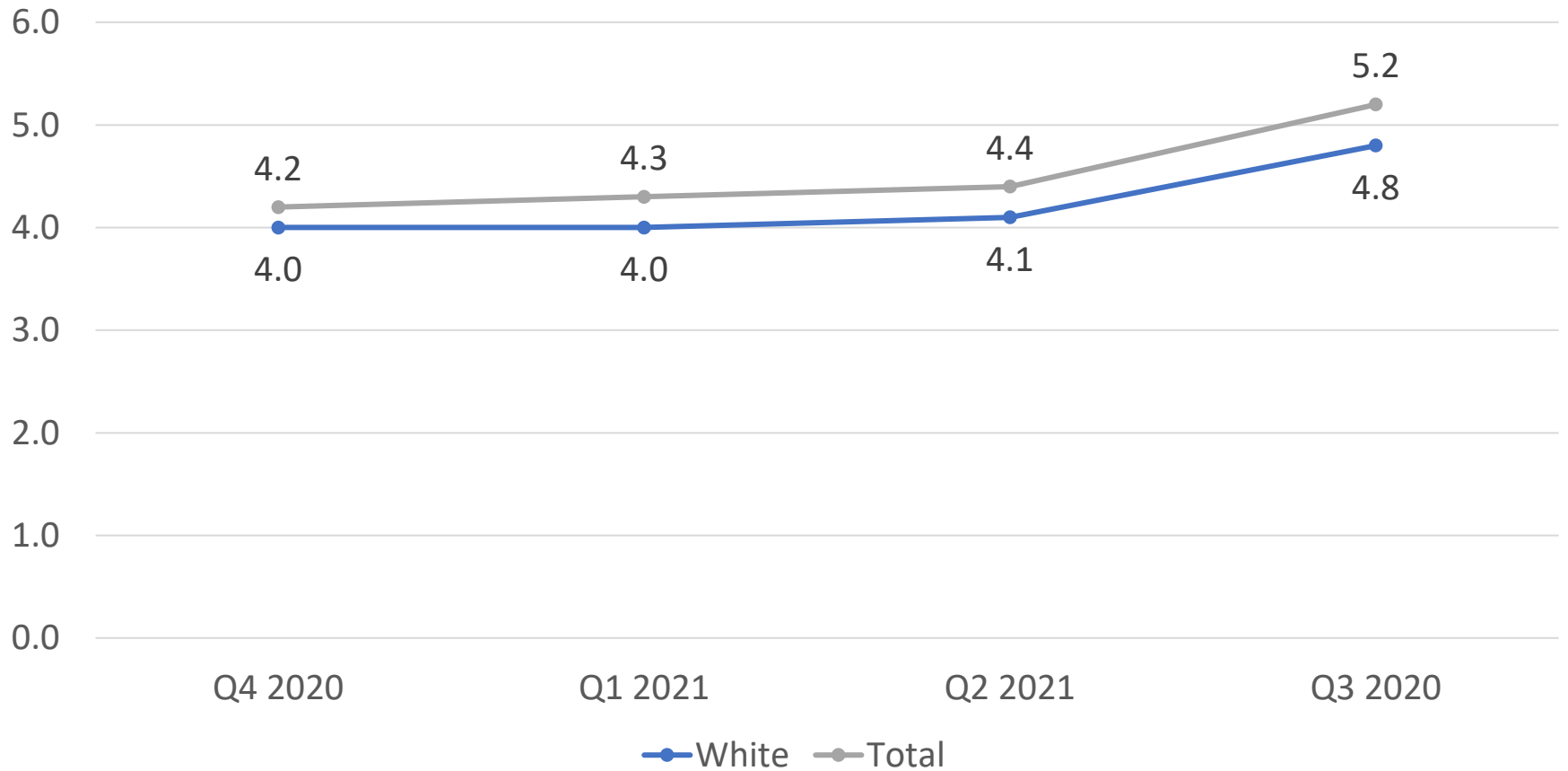

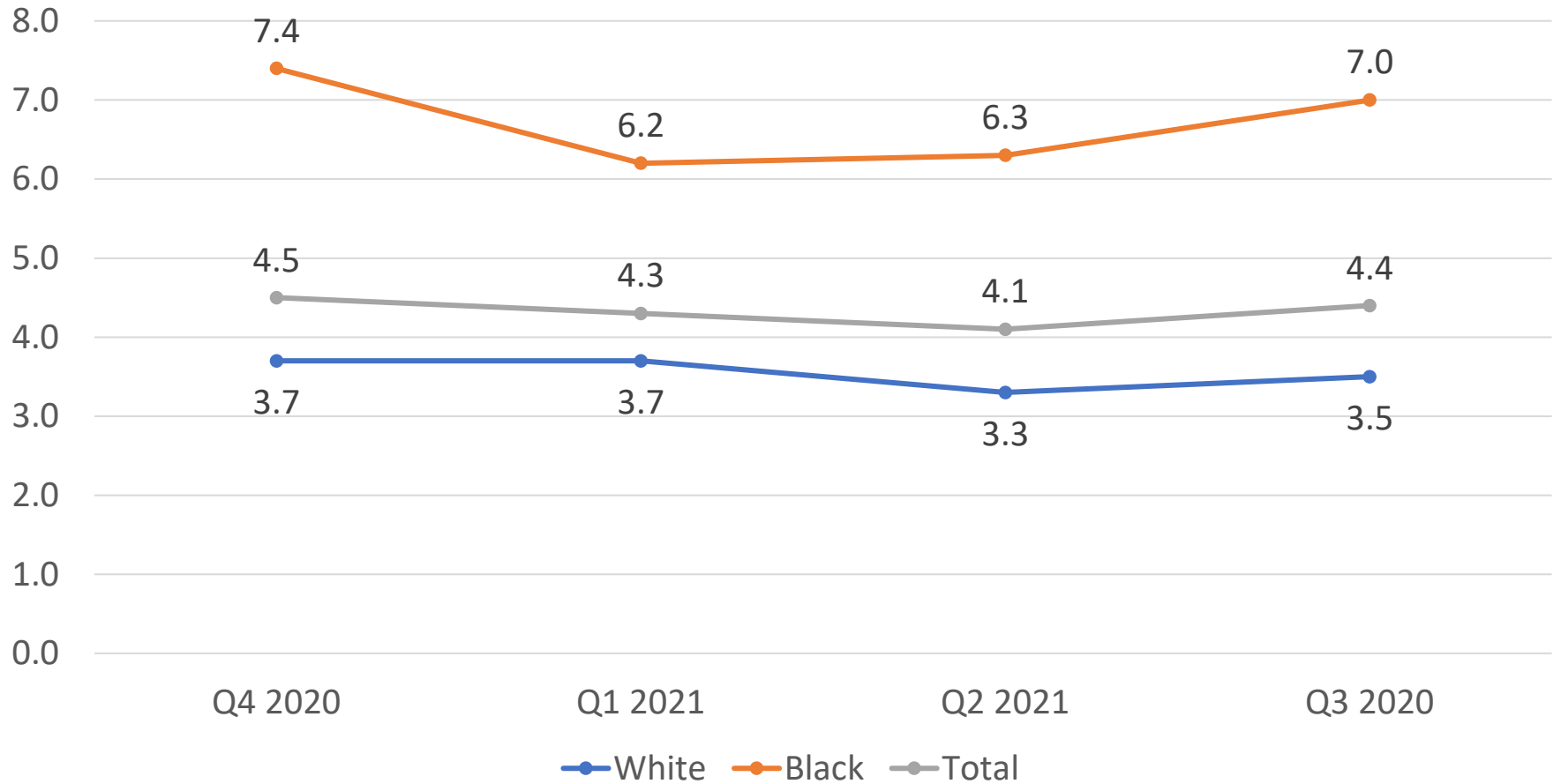

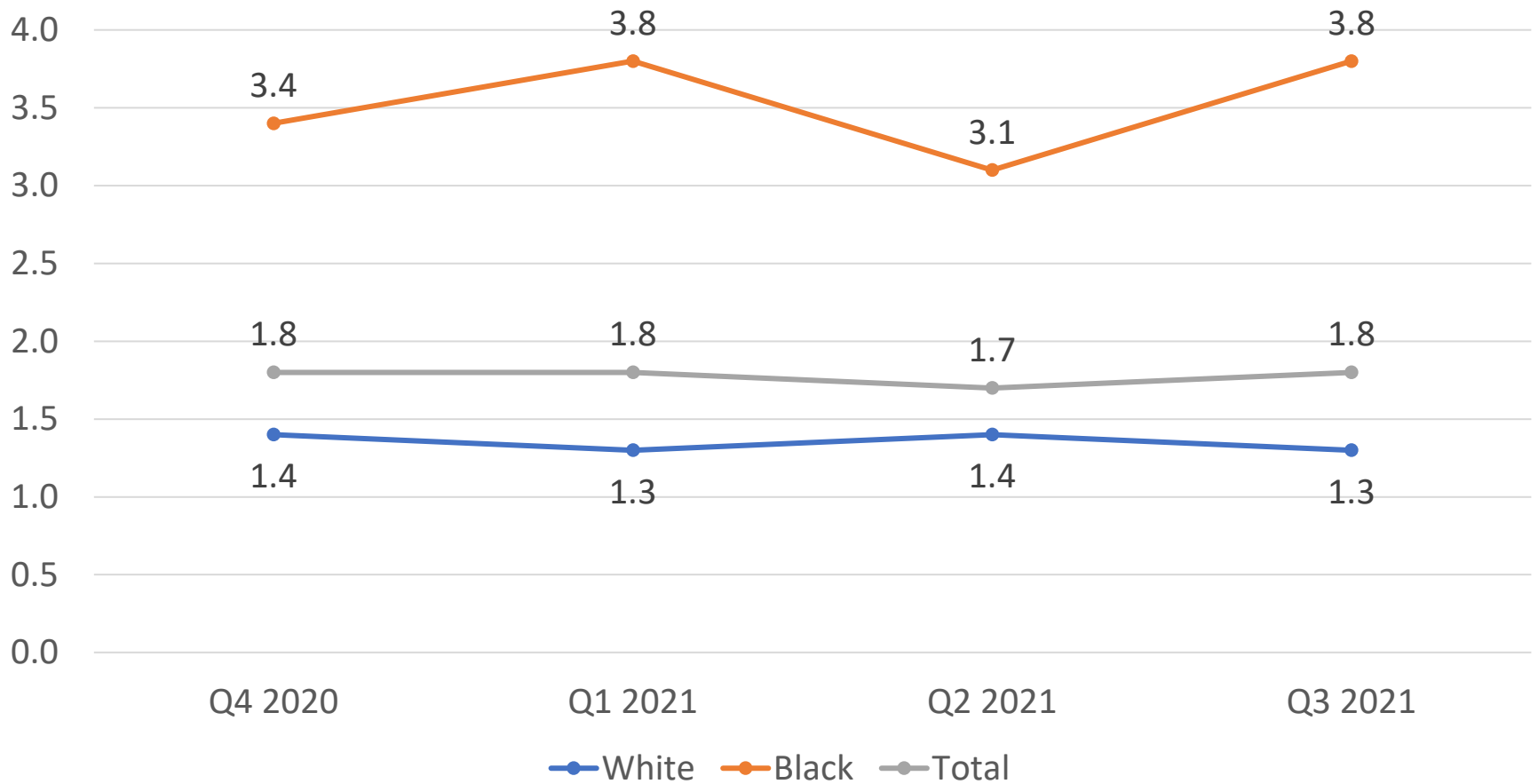
Southwest Region Neonatal Mortality Rates (per 1,000)

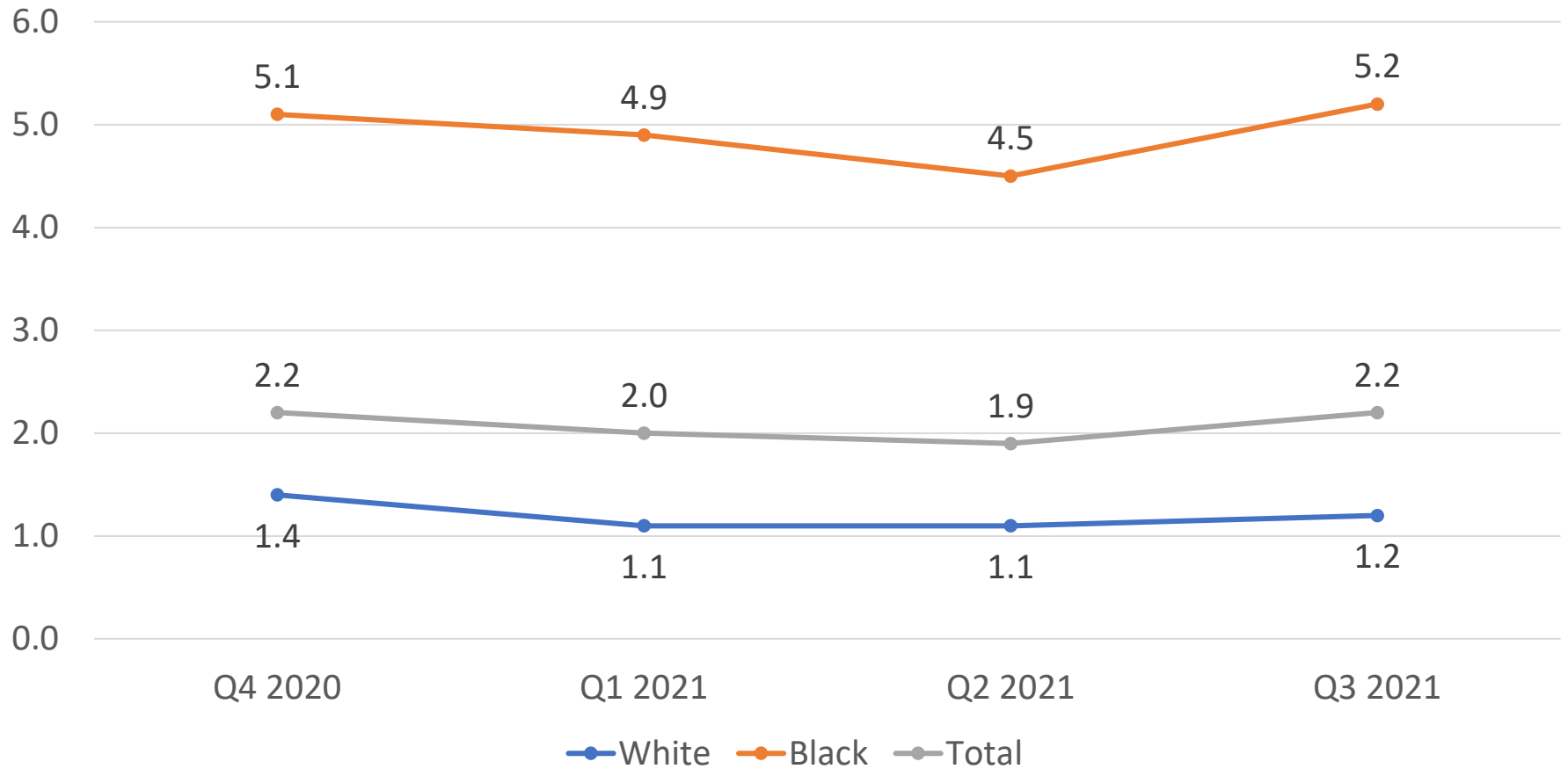
Postneonatal Mortality, by Region and Race

Central Region Postneonatal Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



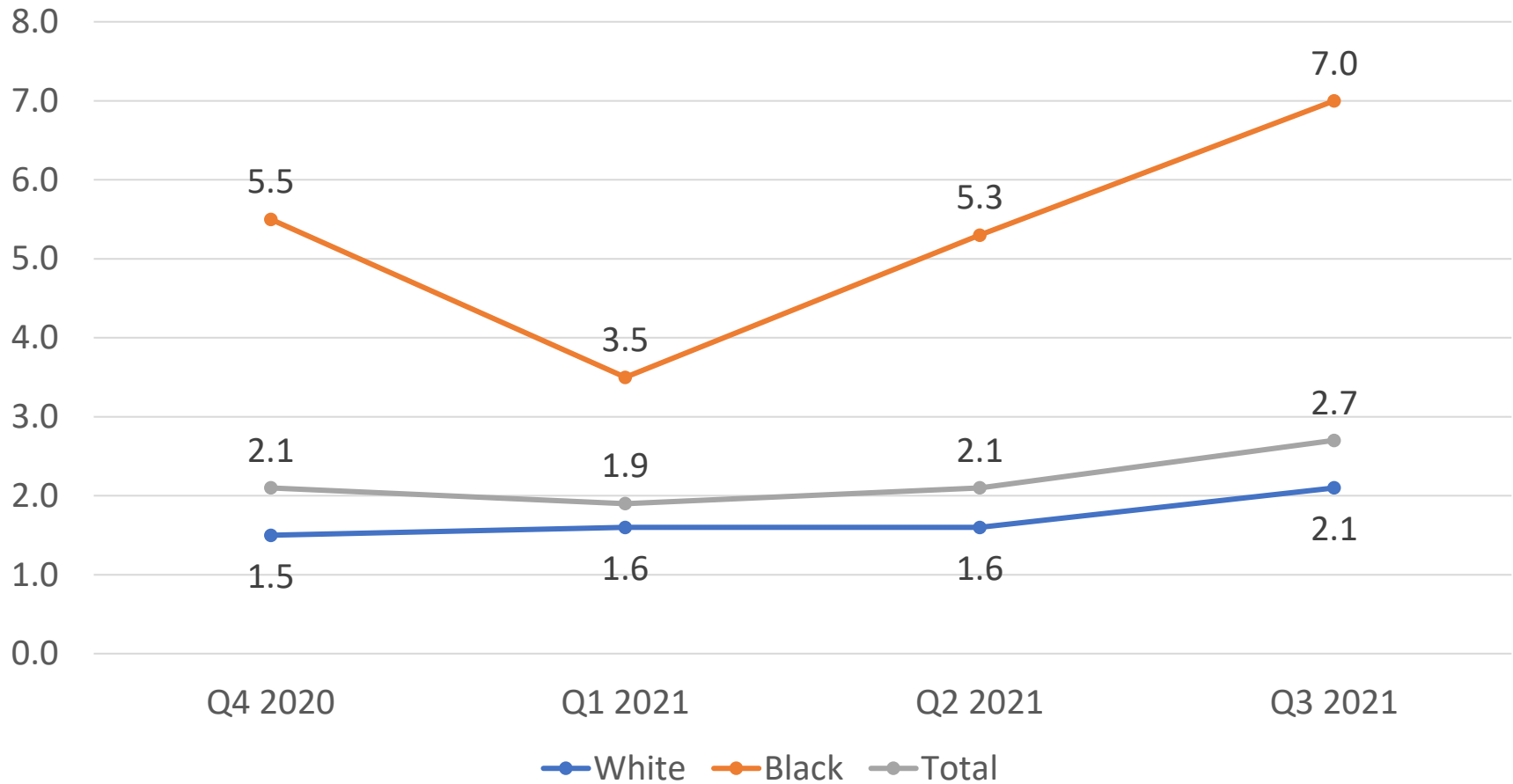

Northeast Region Postneonatal Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



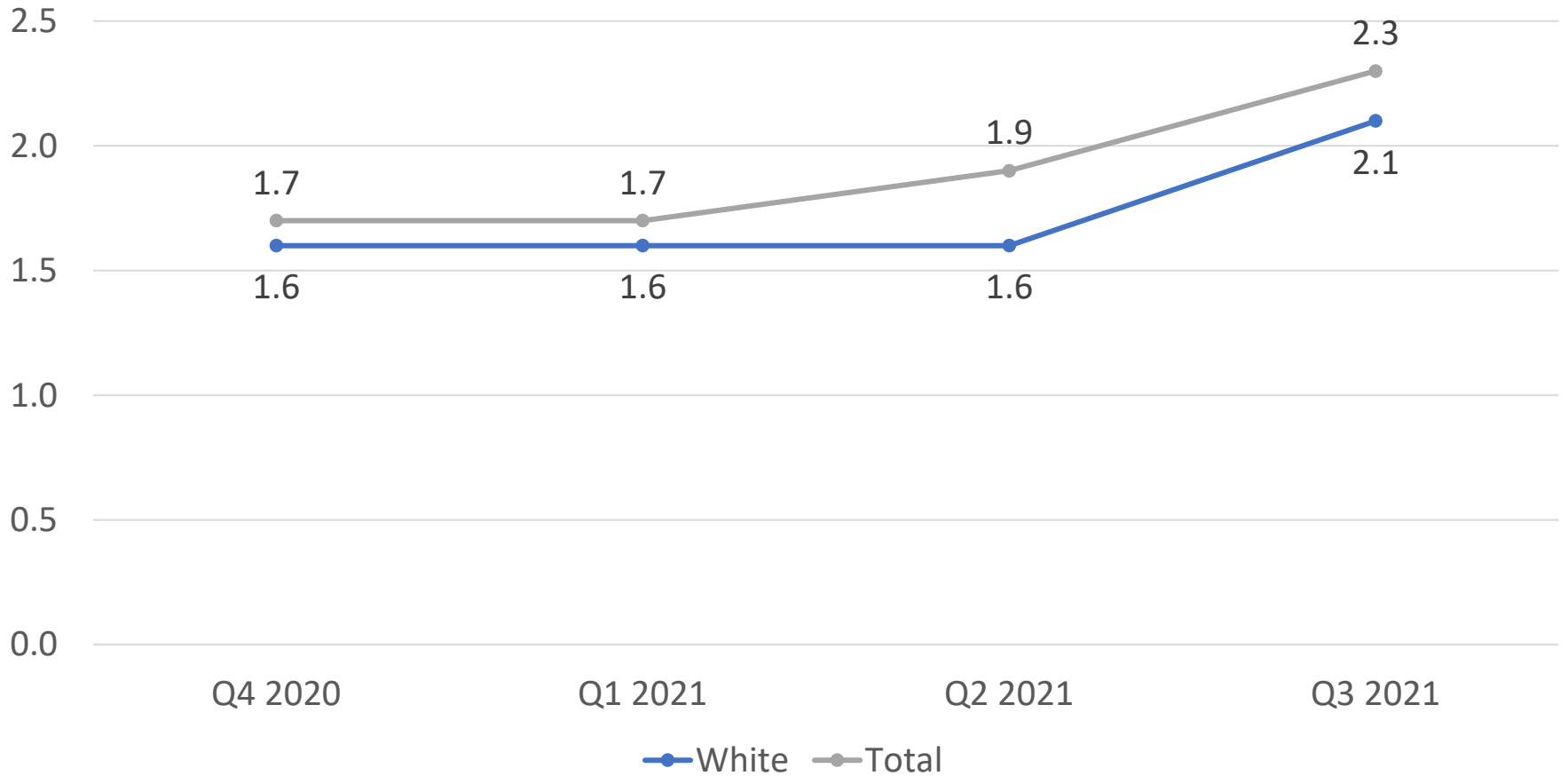

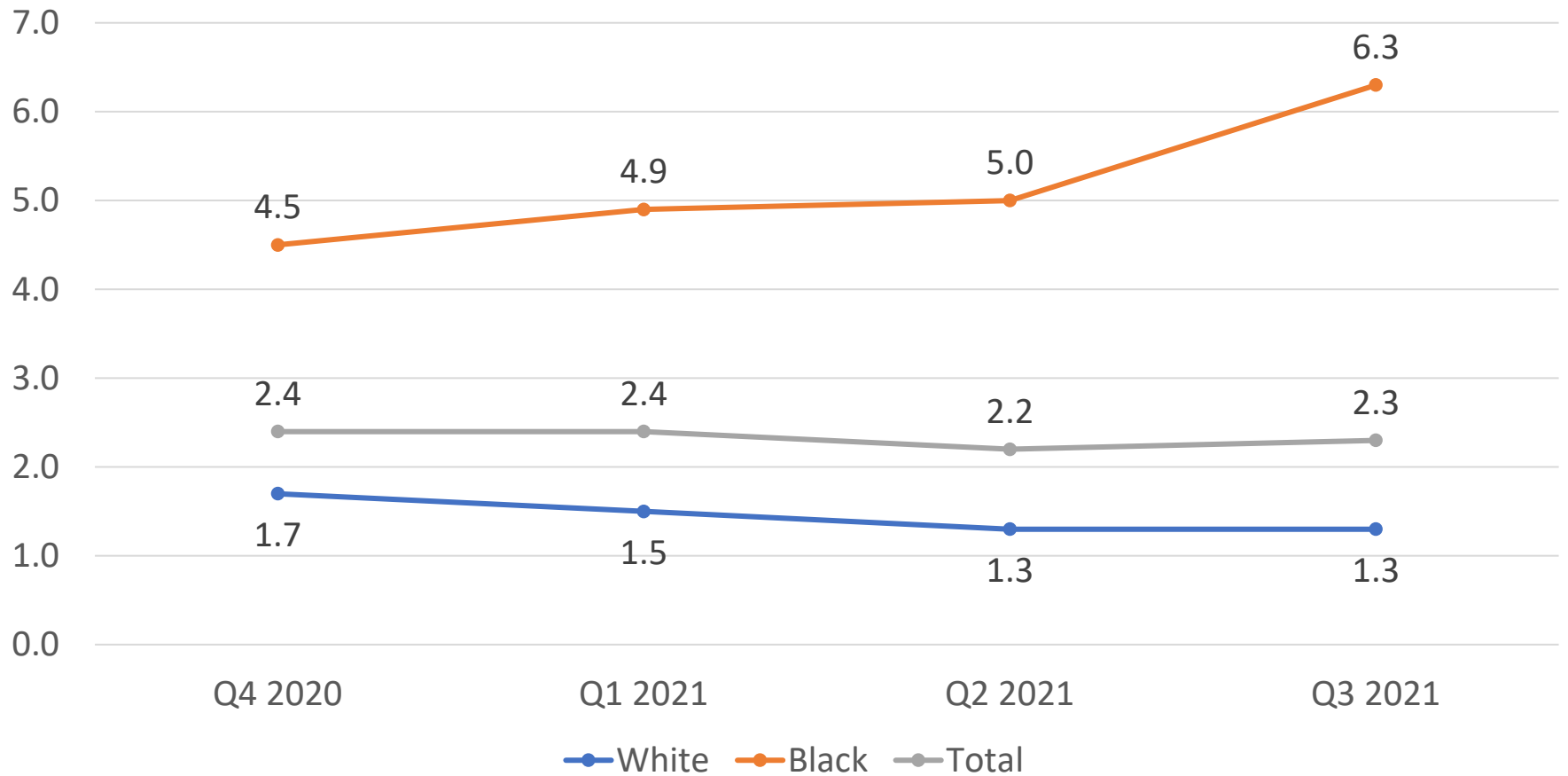

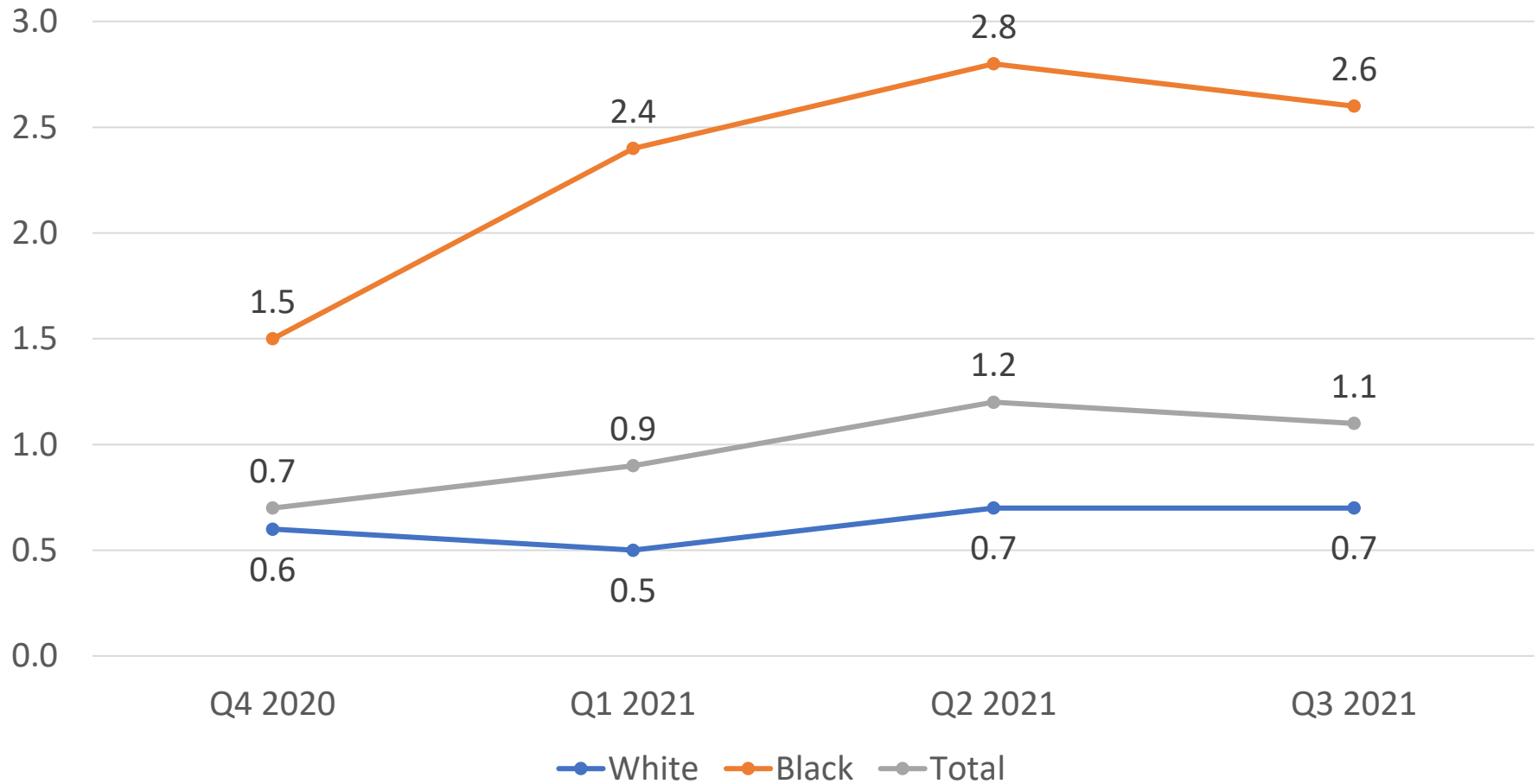

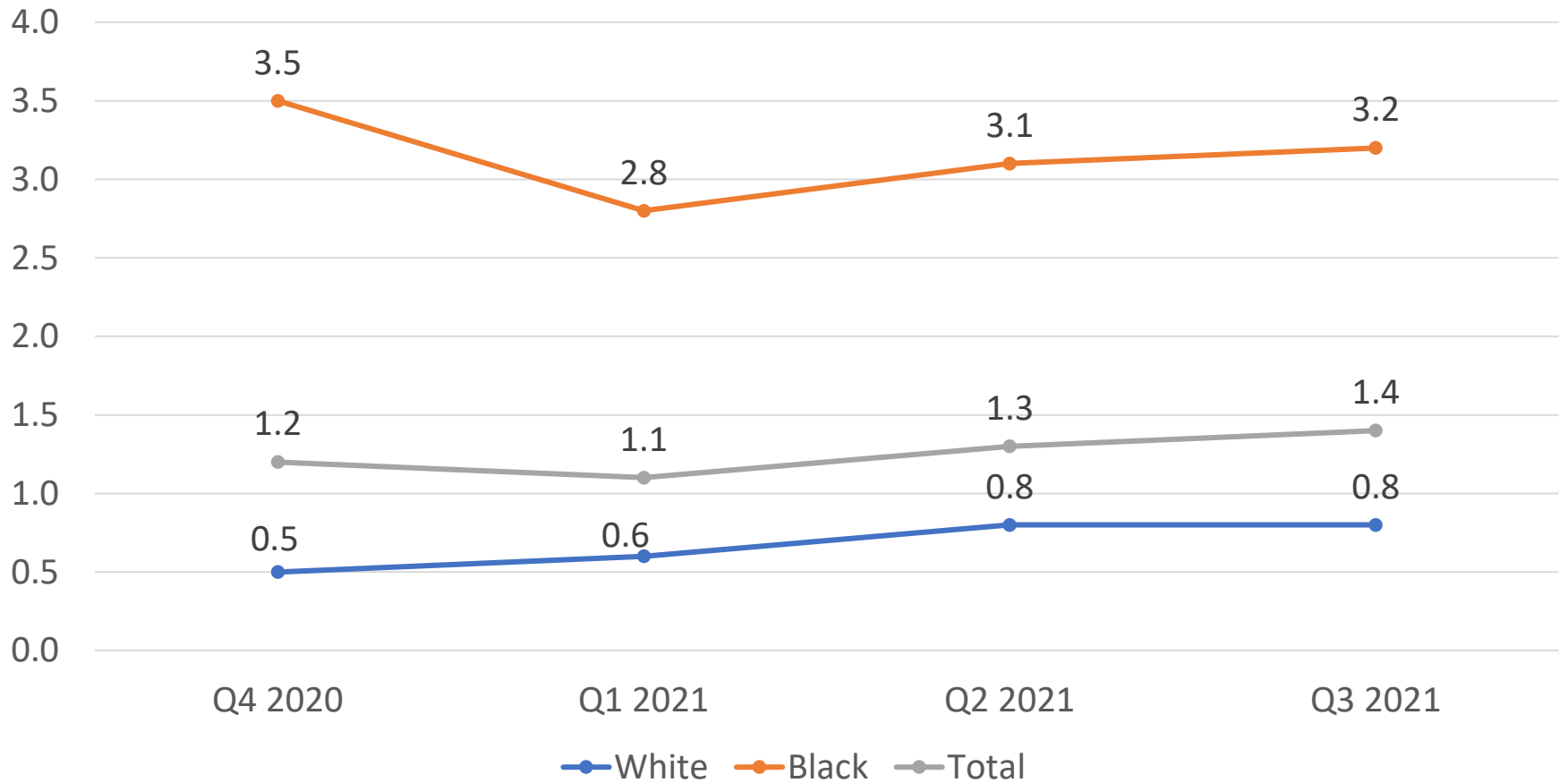

Central Region SUID Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



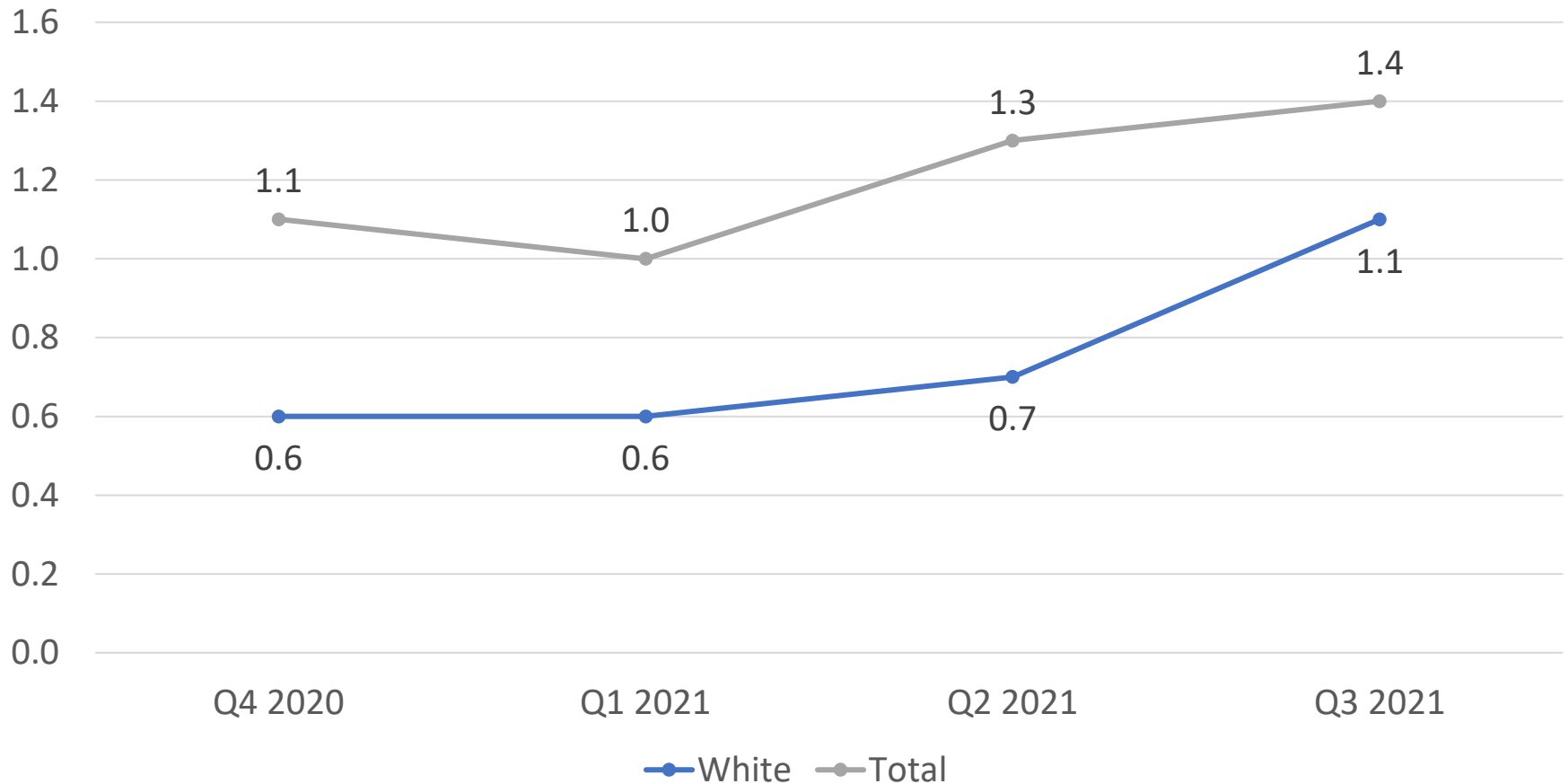

Northeast Region SUID Mortality Rates (per 1,000)



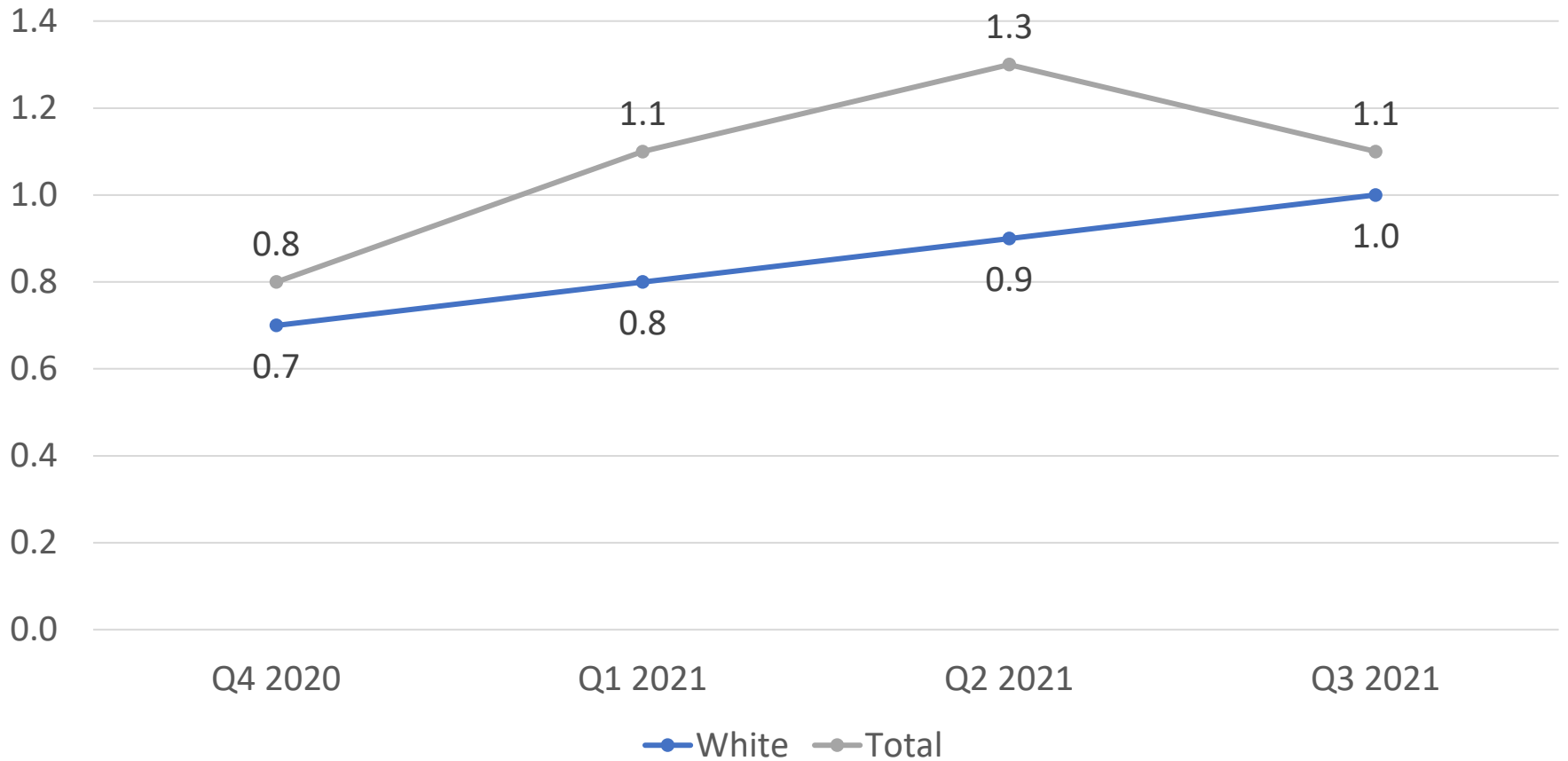

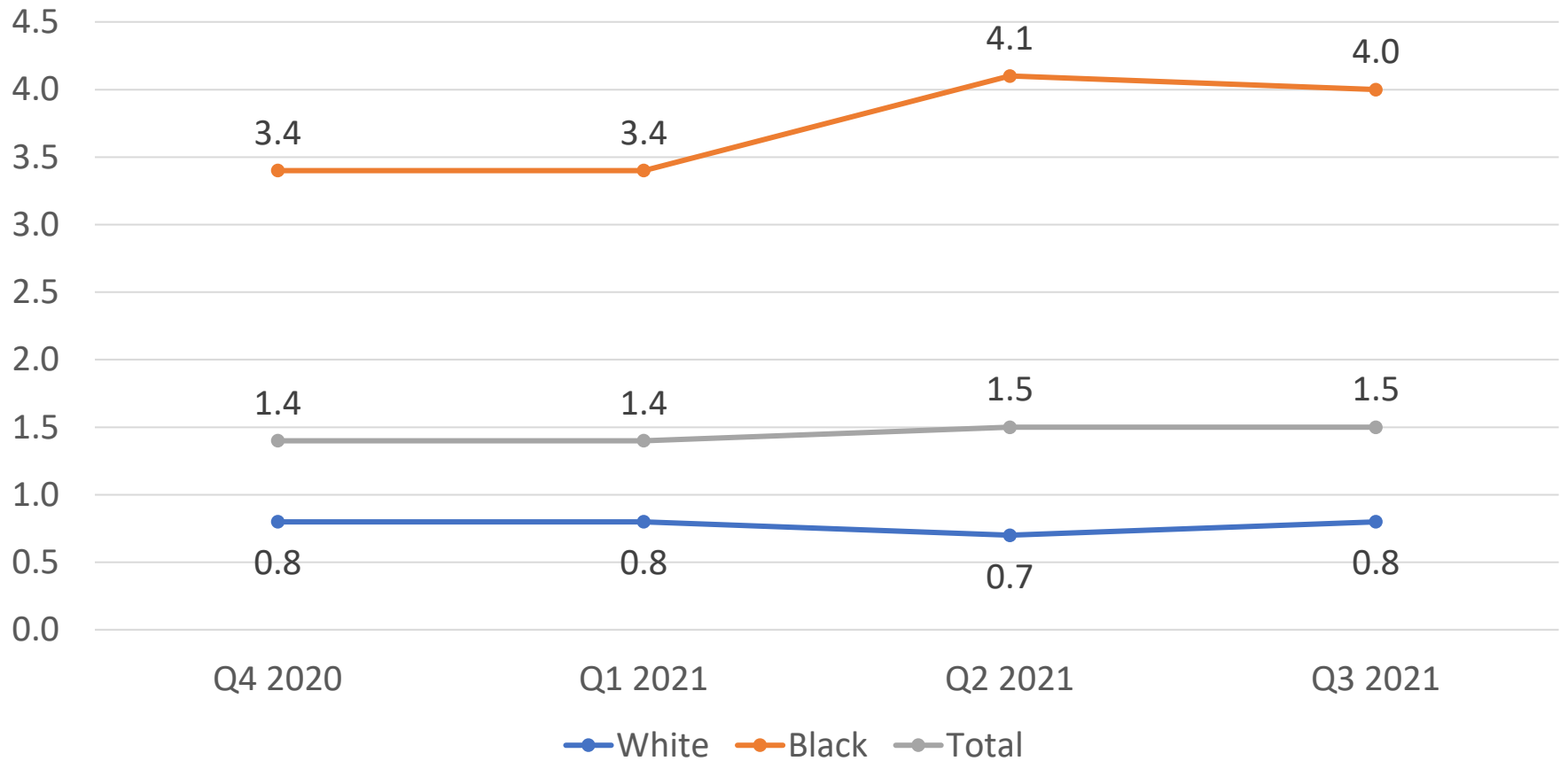

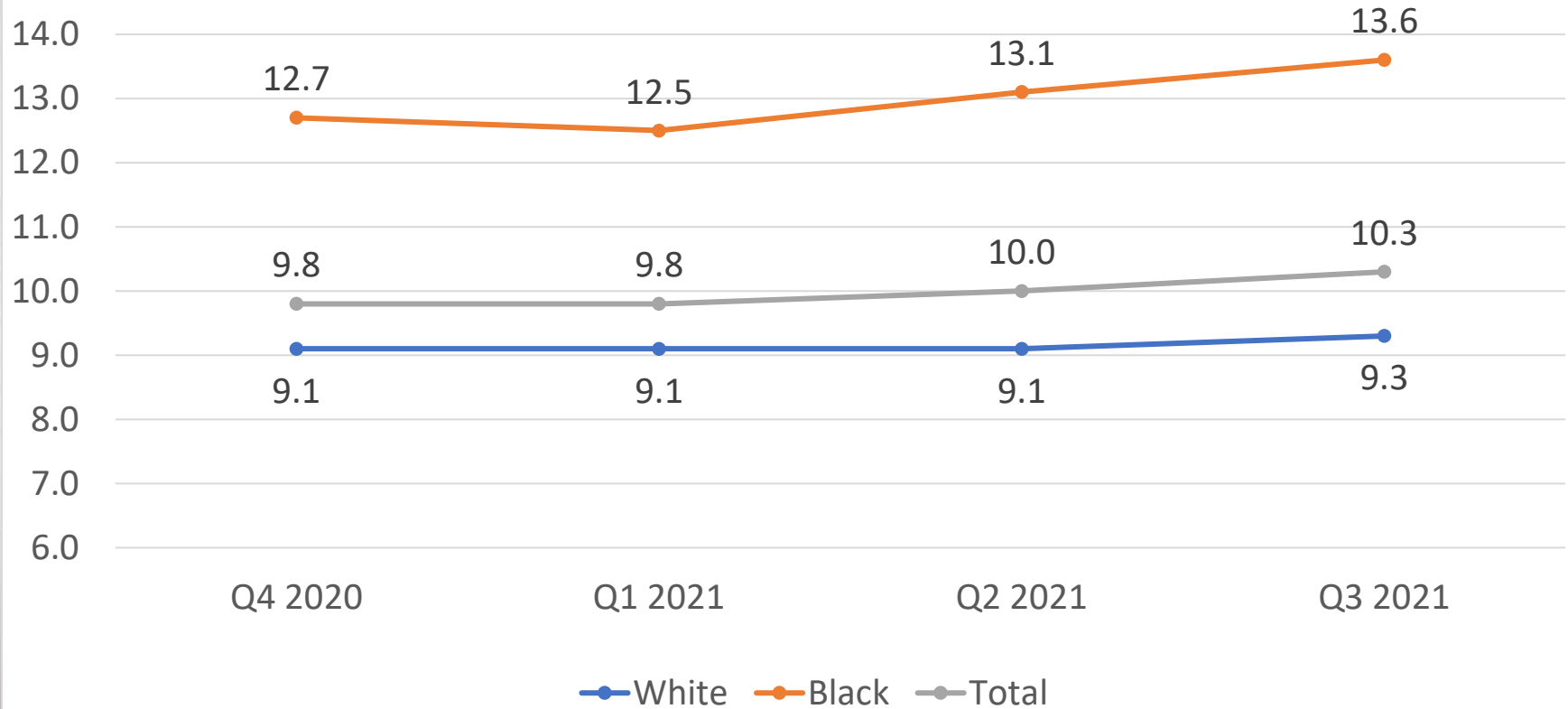

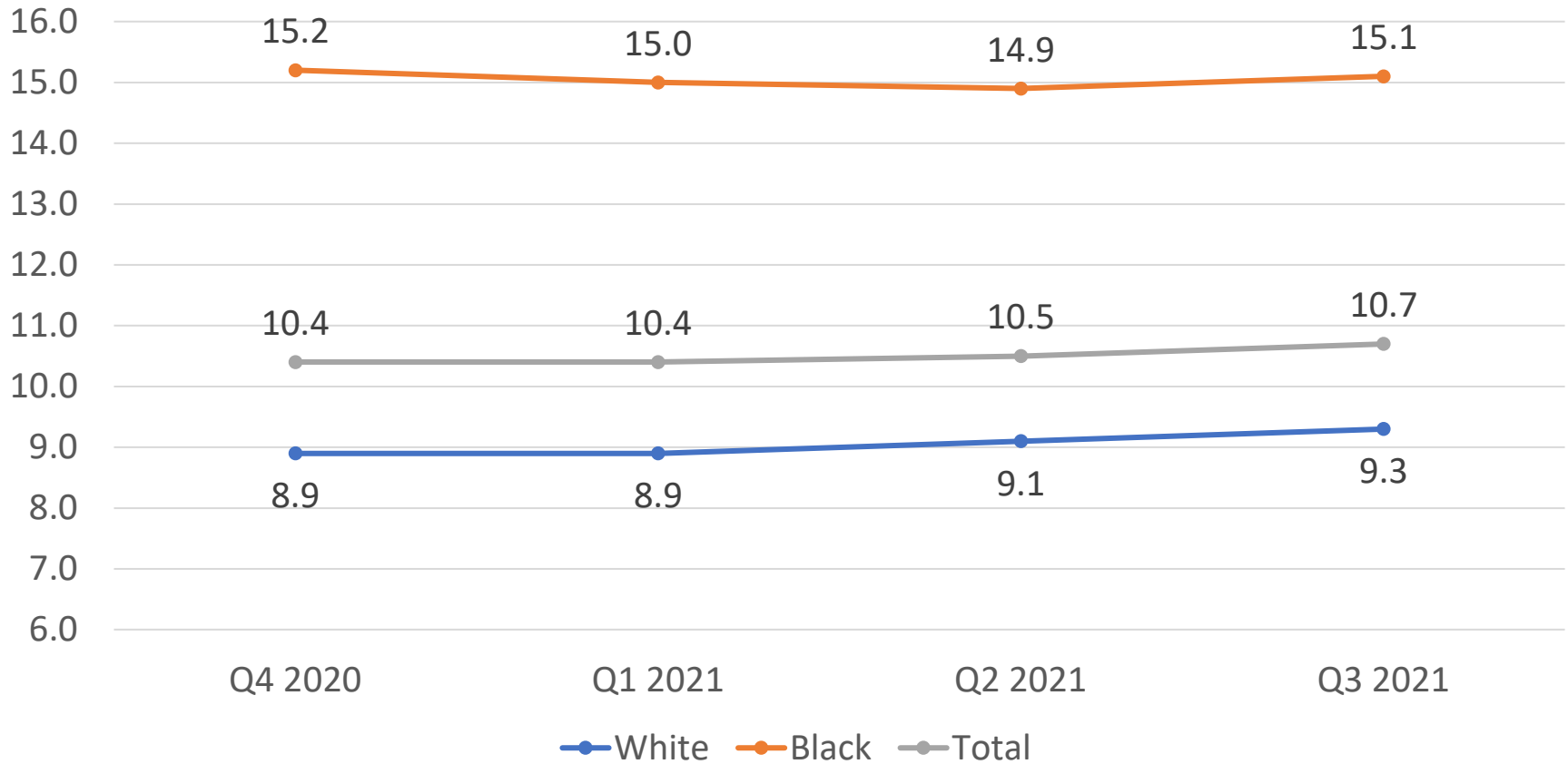

Central Region Percentage Preterm (<37 Weeks) Births



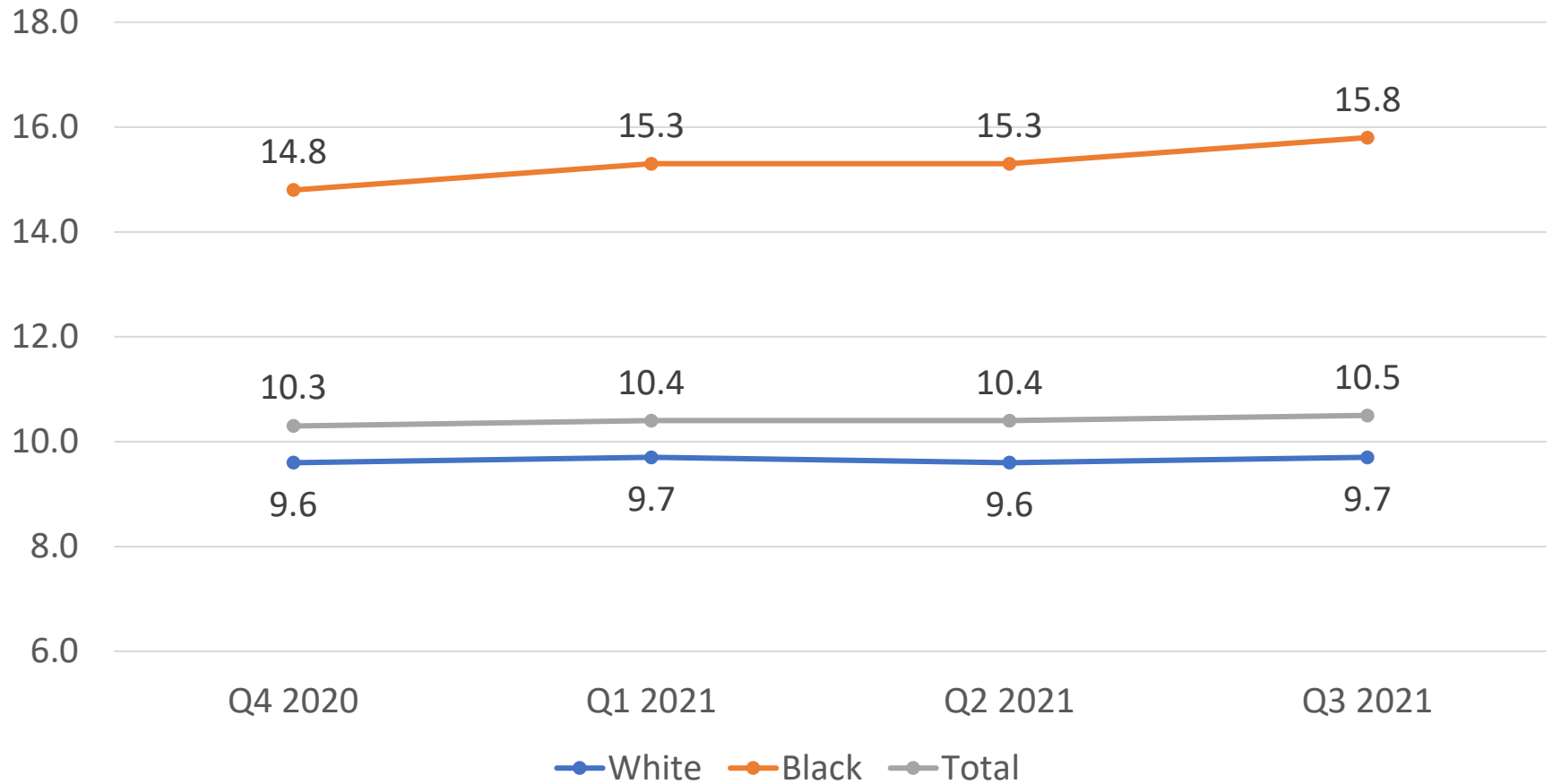

Northeast Region Percentage Preterm (<37 Weeks) Births



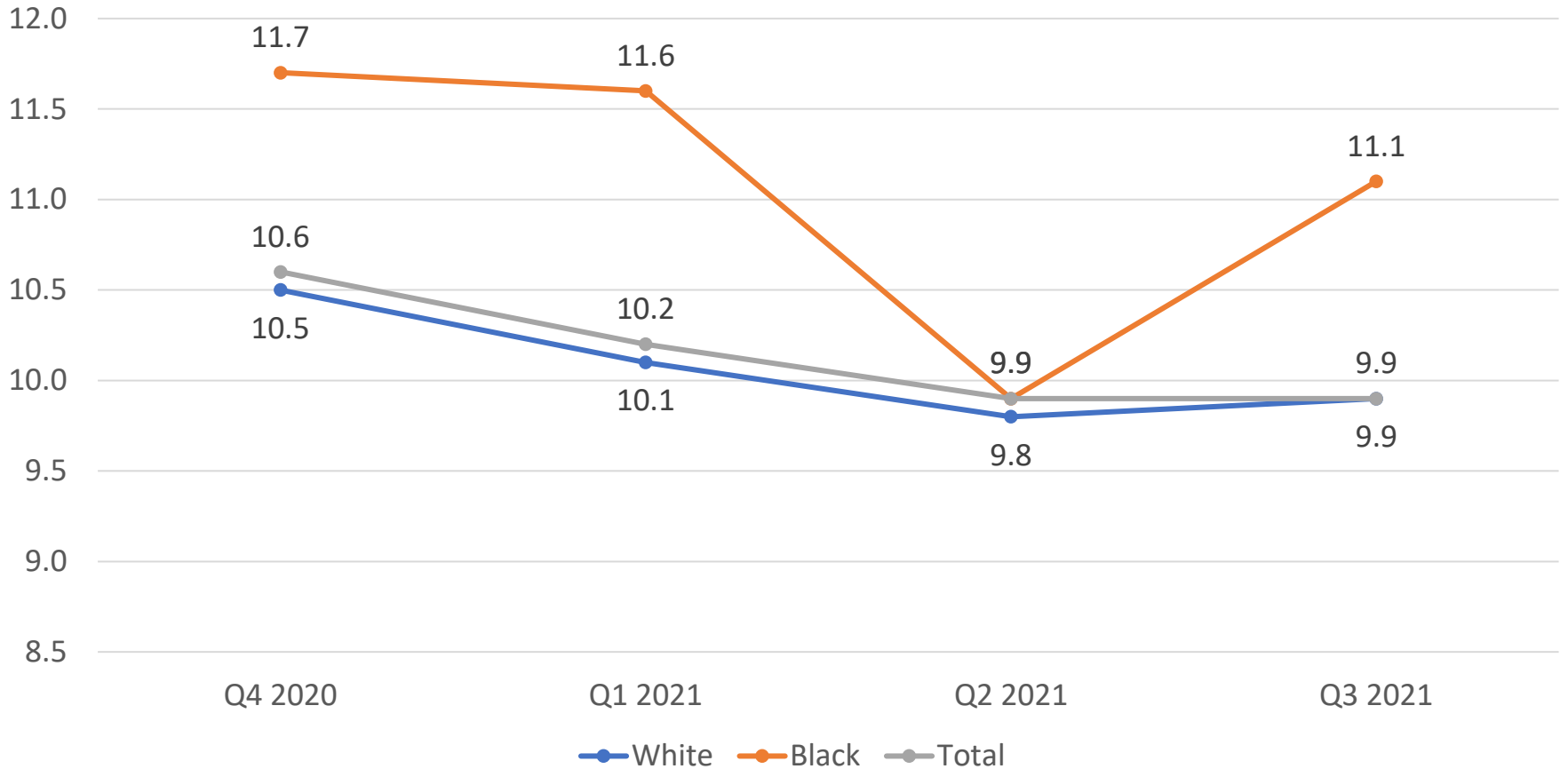

Northwest Region Percentage Preterm (<37 Weeks) Births



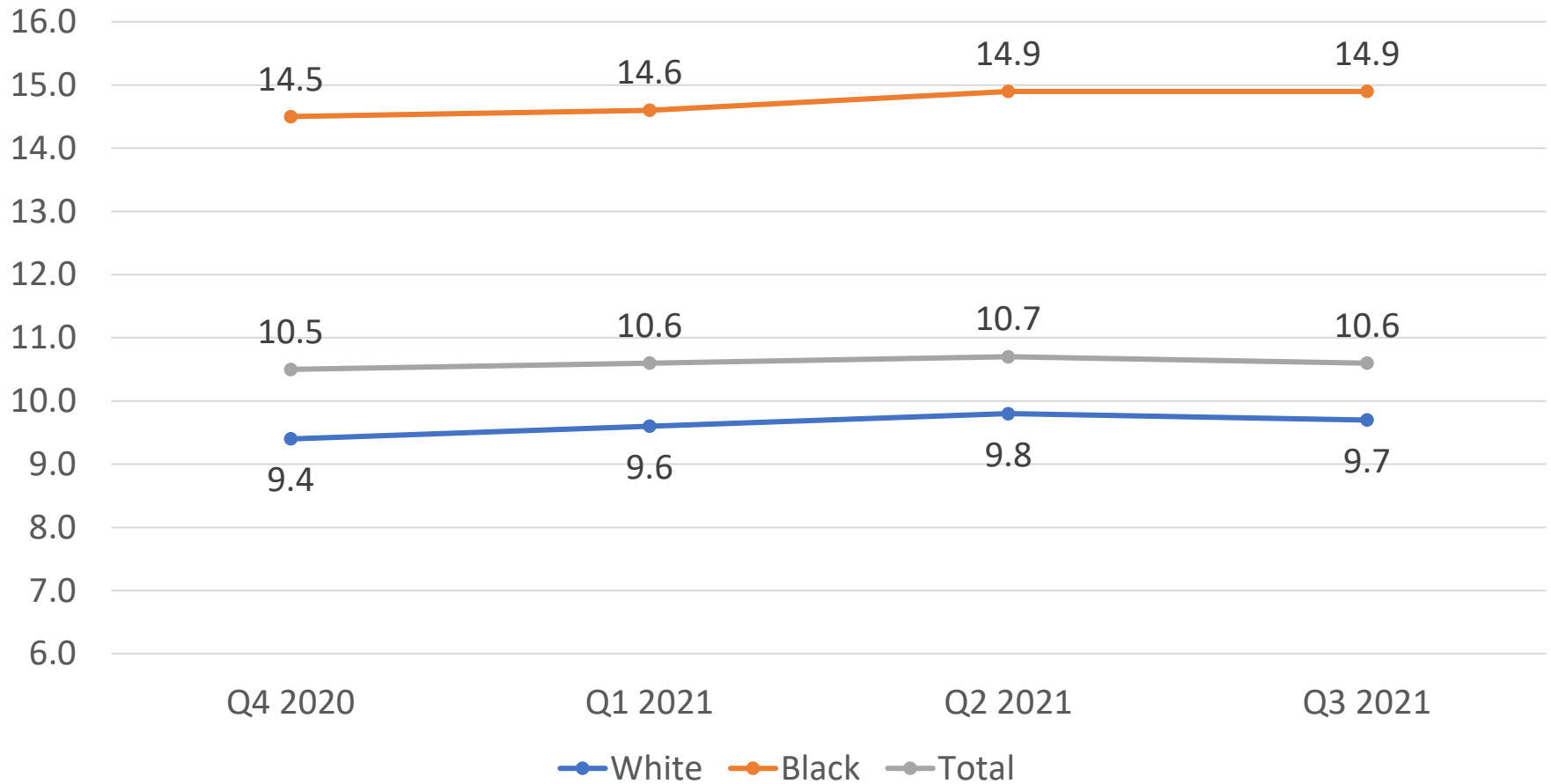

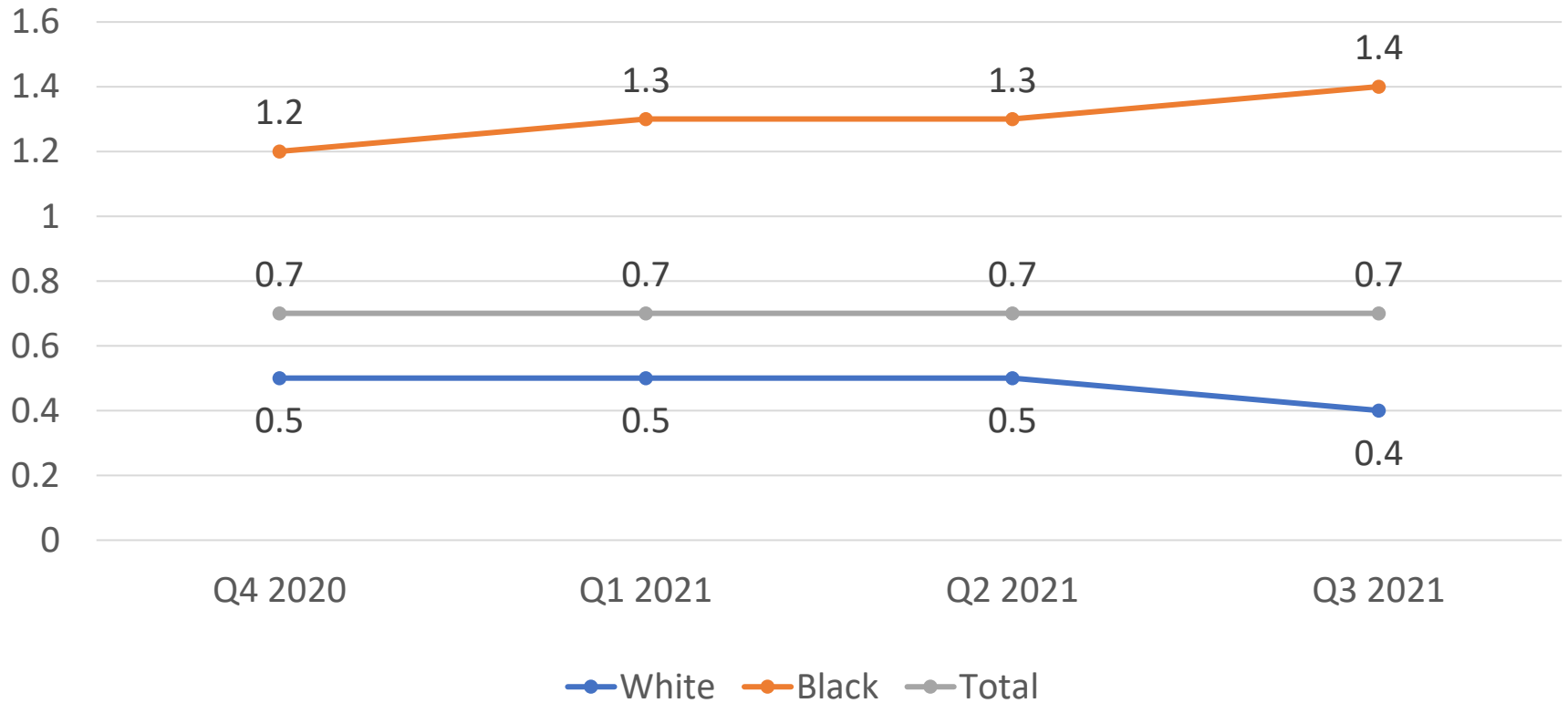
Southwest Region Percentage Preterm (<37 Weeks) Births

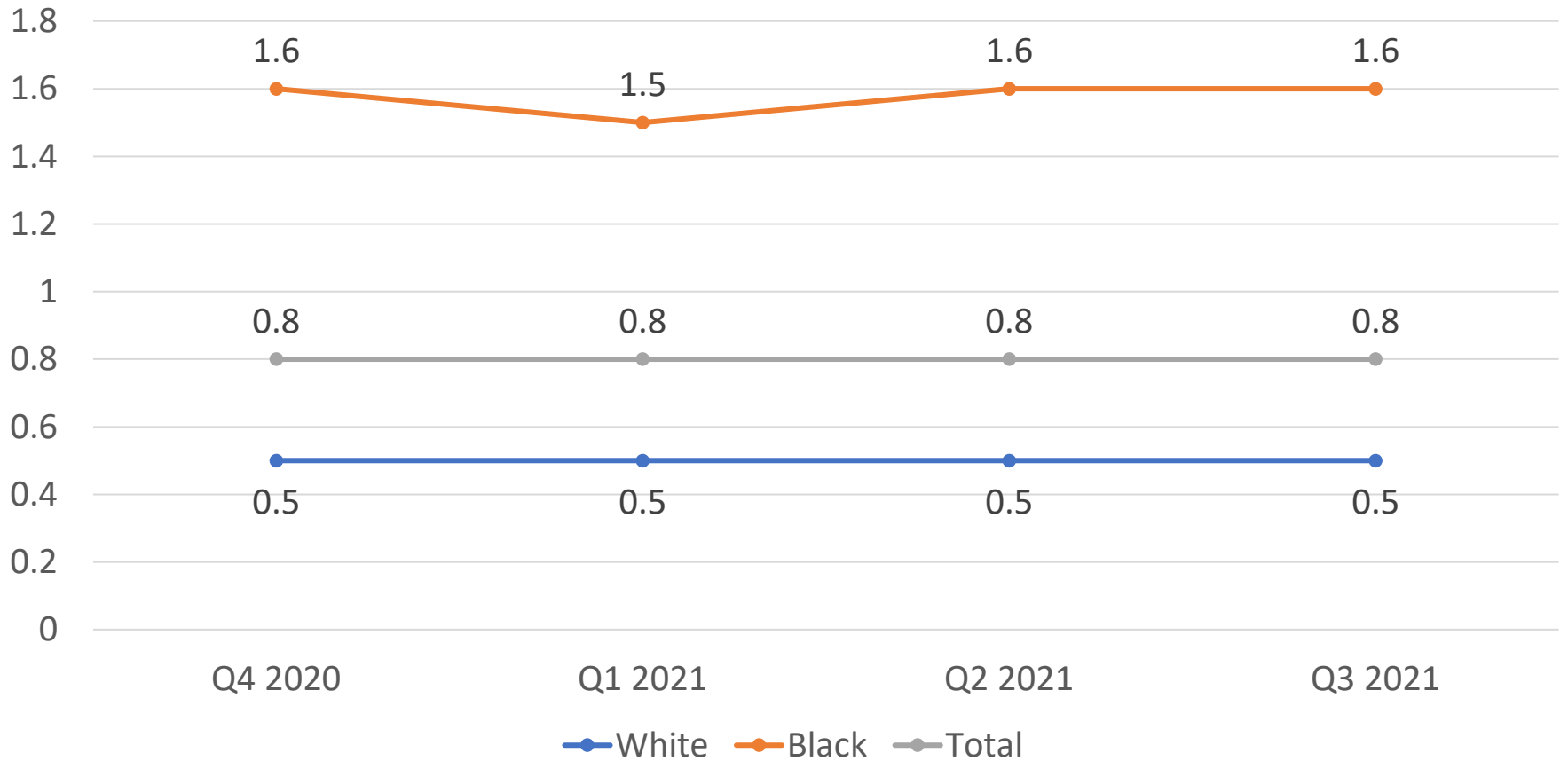

Central Region Percentage Extreme Preterm (<28 Weeks) Births



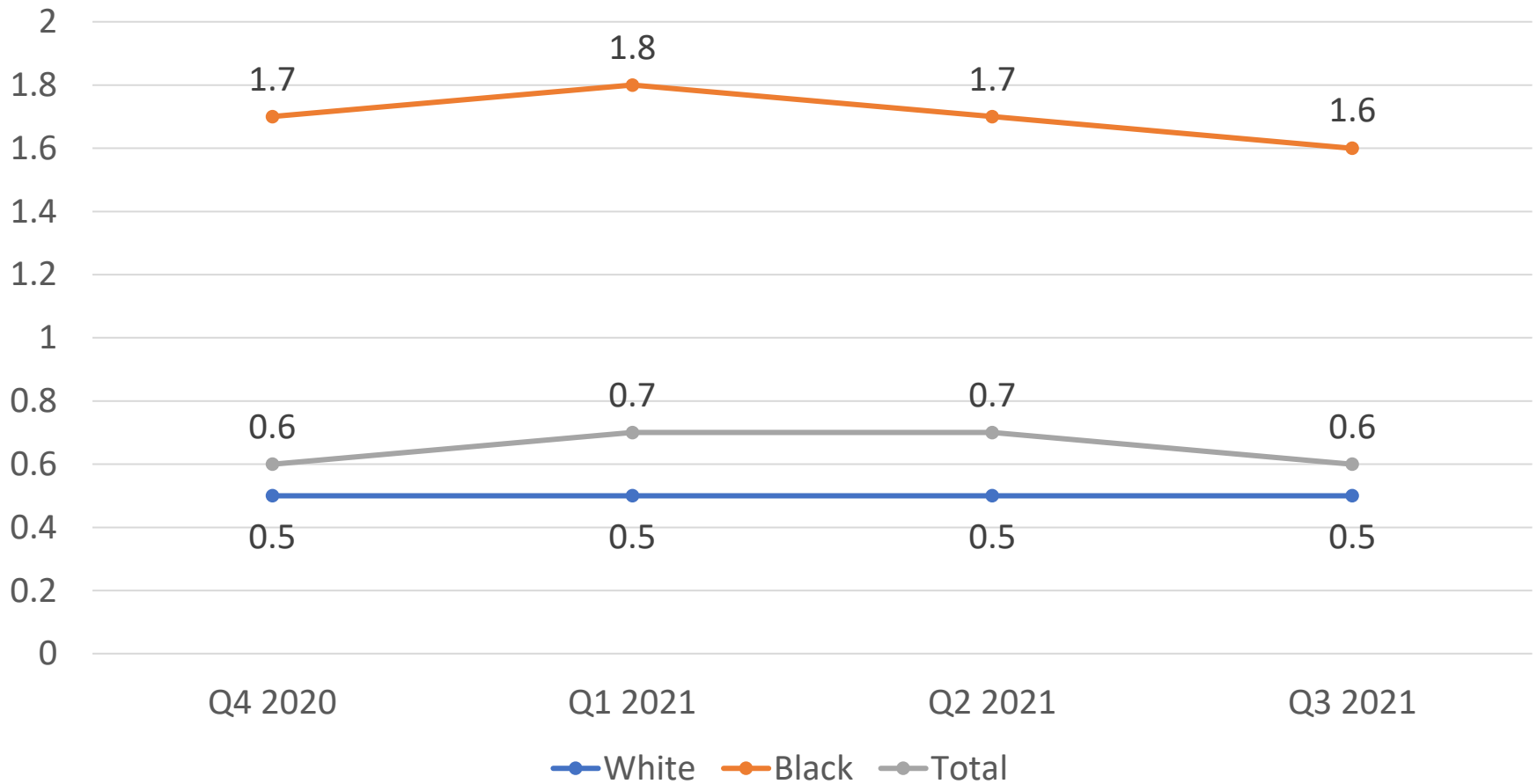

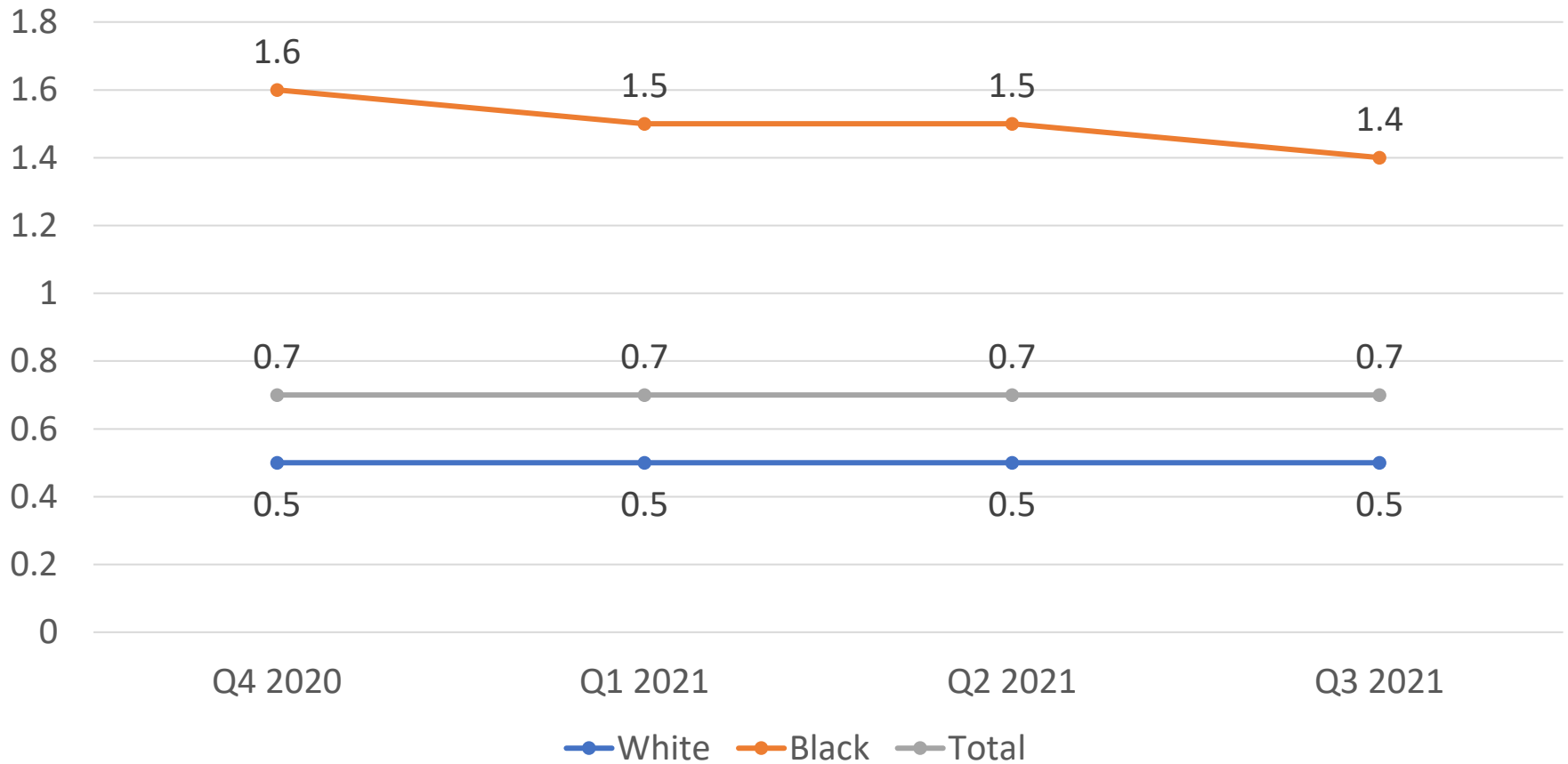
